The Weather



The High yesterday 56° The Low this morning 37°

The forecasters tell us that this morning there was an arctic cold front making its way through the Dallas area. It was expected to reach Central Texas by mid morning. Look for an increase in the northerly winds and increasing cloud cover for a bit. Most of the really frigid air should remain to our northeast, but the steady winds at 10-15 mph from the north will keep the high temperature for us in the 40's. Tonight look for clear and cold with lows in the 20's.

It was also mentioned that the outlook for late February shows below normal temperatures, and above normal precipitation. This will be a good thing for the short-term drought conditions.

Today: clearing with a high near 49°. The wind will be W-NE at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low around 26° and N-NE wind at 5-10 mph.

Friday: Sunny with a high near 53°. Winds will be N-NE at 5-10 mph shifting to the E-SE in the afternoon.

Friday Night: Winds will be SE at 5-10 mph. Skies will be mostly clear with a low of 37°.

Saturday: Warming up with mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 65°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Saturday Night: 46° with partly cloudy skies, and S wind at 5-10 mph.

Sunday: A high temperature near 75° with mostly sunny skies and W-SW wind at 5-10 mph

Lampasas Pursuit

The Lampasas Police Dept. shared the following press release on February 12th:

“On February 11 at 5:52pm, we received information about a motorist



that displayed a firearm. Our Patrol Sergeant located the vehicle and attempted to make a traffic stop on that vehicle and they fled. The chase led them through east Lampasas to Bell County where they crashed at FM 116 and Lomas Rodando Calzada Rd. Two Police Department units, a deputy and highway patrol were involved in the chase.
