The Weather



High yesterday was $64^\circ\,$ The low this morning was $51^\circ\,$

Today: Sunny, and up to 79° with strong S-SW wind 10-15 mph and gusting to 25.

Tonight: Overnight it will be partly cloudy, 60s and upper 50s for temperatures, and the wind will calm a lot.

Friday: Mostly sunny and even warmer, likely getting into the mid 80s. Overnight it will go down to the mid-40s as the wind shifts to north with the arrival of a weak cold front.

The Weekend: Saturday will be much cooler as the cold front seems a little stronger than thought yesterday. It will probably hold Saturday down to a high of about 67° and down to 50 or below overnight. The good news is that the wind will be light. On Sunday the high should be about 66° or so and overnight down to about 40° .

Next week: A small rain chance comes Monday and it will increase to 30-40% thru Tuesday. Wednesday should be sunny.

in Lampasas last Friday saw 39 cases come before the bench with 18 cases reset. Pre-trials were set in 3 cases. Bond was found insufficient in one case, and reduced in another.

Aaron Schoch, Brandon Zirkle, and Jordan Miller failed to appear and warrants were issued. Two jury announcements were made, one for March 25th, and one For April 5th. Vincent Williams received 5 years in TDCJ with credit for time served plus court fees for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance. Amber Reed saw her probation revoked and is sentenced to 9 months State Jail with credit for time served for possession of a controlled substance. Steven Stem, also for possession of controlled substance, saw his probation revoked and received 12 months state jail with credit for time served plus court fees. Michael Morales was given 4 years deferred adjudication with a \$750 fine plus court costs for evading arrest/detention with a vehicle. Felicia Daponte received 5 year deferred adjudication plus court costs for Debit/ Credit abuse of the elderly.
