The Weather

The High yesterday 75° The Low this morning 56°

Today: Sunny, with a high near 87°? Is this really happening? It sure looks that way. The wind has been pretty stiff and it looks to continue that way until late today or tonight. Today's forecast is for W-SW wind, 10 to 20 mph typical, and gusting to 25 mph.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low of 45°. The wind will decrease, shift to W-NW about 10 mph, then shift to N-NE after midnight.

Saturday: Mostly sunny with a high near 72° in the afternoon. The N-NE wind will be 5-10 mph, then shifting to south in the afternoon. But...it will shift again after midnight to the W-NW and be very light.

Sunday will be mostly sunny with a high near 65° as the wind, coming generally northerly, will be light.

Next week: Monday's long range forecast has a drop in the high down to about 52° in the afternoon, behind a 10 mph NE wind.

Monday night there will be a 30% chance of rain after 7pm. That will increase to 50% on Tuesday and Tuesday night. Some sort of wind chance is in our forecast most of next week. Temperatures next week seem to be typically 50s afternoons and down to upper 30s or low 40s overnights.

Warning! Rabid skunk in town!



City of Lampasas Animal Control Officer Joe Schwartzer was informed on Feb. 14th that a skunk has tested positive for rabies. The skunk was found dead in a yard, in the area of the 1500 block of Taylor St. in Lampasas. The skunk was sent for testing to the Texas Department of State Health Services and has tested positive for rabies.

This is the first rabid skunk in the city this year, according to Lampasas Animal Control Officer Joe Schwartzer.

The Lampasas Police Department encourages anyone who sees an animal that appears to be sick or acting strange to call the Police Dept. at (512) 556-3644 and report it.

- You should not attempt to handle wildlife, regardless of whether it appears to be healthy or sick, as it could be infectious.
- •Don't leave food outside as it attracts wildlife.
- Teach your children to never touch wildlife.

- •Skunks are active this time of year and have your pet vaccinated to protect it against rabies, especially if your pet spends any time outdoors.
- Rabies is transmitted through saliva, typically in bites.
- •If you are bitten, immediately wash the wound with soap and water. Seek medical aid as soon as possible to determine whether treatment is needed to prevent rabies. Once symptoms of rabies begin, the disease is fatal.
- •If your pet is bitten, immediately a local veterinarian.
- If you or your pet are bitten, contact your local animal control immediately.

Blood Drive



There are many reasons why a hospital patient requires blood; they vary as to the quantities of blood and blood products required to resolve each medical issue faced. On average, a heart surgeon may request six units of blood and blood products for the patient.

Victims facing trauma injuries from an auto accident may require 50 or more units of blood to replace their loss. Organ transplant experts may order up to 40 units of blood and products – like platelets and plasma – to provide hope for a waiting organ recipient.

Carter BloodCare must register approximately 1,000 donors each day to keep up with hospital demand for blood products. If each eligible blood donor gave just one more time per year, there would seldom be a blood shortage.


