The Weather



High yesterday was 55° Low this morning was 37°

The southerly winds today will be pulling in moisture, and continuing the warming trend, even if the clouds roll in. With the southern winds continuing look for a warmer night with lows in the upper 30's northwest to low 50's to the southeast.

Monday night look for a considerable wind shift out of the north.

Tuesday's high of 62° may actually occur in the morning as the cold air filters in through the day. Look for the rain chances to increase Tuesday night and into

Wednesday. While it looks like the rain will be off and on, the day will be dismal. The rain showers will continue through Thursday.

Today: Partly sunny with winds from the S at 5-15 mph. The high temperature will be near 64°.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with S winds at 5 mph. The low will be near 47°.

Sunday: Partly sunny, then clearing with a high temperature near 79°. W-SW wind at 5-10 mph.

Sunday Night: A low temperature near 54° and mostly clear skies. Winds will be S -SW at 5-10 mph.

President's Day: Skies will be mostly sunny with the temperature reaching to near 80°. Wind will be S-SW at 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Monday Night: A low near 52° and mostly cloudy skies with S winds at 5- 10 mph.

Tuesday: Mostly cloudy with a high near 62 and a 30% chance of storms. Wind will be N at 10-15 increasing to 15-20 as the day progresses with gusts as high as 25 mph

Election Update

Yesterday was the last day to file to run in the city general election on May 2nd.

The City of Lampasas has 3 City Council Seats that are expiring, places 3, 4 & 5 are up for grabs.

Cathy Kuehne, the incumbent for place 4 appears to be running unopposed. Chuck Williamson, (retired) the incumbent for place 3 is running, and Gordon Nelson (also retired) has also filed to run for place 3. Place 5 has 2 newcomers, as Mike White, the incumbent did not file to keep his place. Zachary Taylor (operations manager) has filed to run for place 5, as has Bob Goodart (retired).

Lampasas ISD, according to our information will be filling places 6 & 7 during the general election. Sam Walker, incumbent has filed for Place 6 and Ryan Shahan, incumbent, has filed for Place 7. He is also an incumbent.



The City of Lometa has 2 City Council places expiring, Shad Hill and Larry Koch. Larry has filed for re-election, and Doug Brister and Ronnie Cartwright have filed for places at large.

Mayor Carlos Garcia has also filed for re-election and is according to our information is running unopposed.

Lometa ISD has 2 places at large up for election in May, and Courtney Duncan and Mario Maldonado have filed to run in the regular election. Due to a resignation, Lometa ISD is also holding a special election to fill that vacant seat. Amanda Tower has filed to run in the special election. The General Election is May 2nd, and early voting begins on February 18th.

City Water Notes



The City of Lampasas is implementing a water meter replacement project to replace the aged water meters in our water distribution system. Over the course of the next two weeks, Core and Main Utilities, on behalf of the City of Lampasas Public Works Department, will begin installing new water meters in designated areas of the city.

This process will require a representative of Core and Main to access your property for a short period of time to replace the existing water meter. The technician will try to make contact before turning off the water or accessing your property.

***Also..don't forget that the City of Lampasas** and Kempner Water are implementing a temporary conversion to free chlorine to help rid distribution pipes of organic matter and improve the quality of your water overall.

This will begin on February 15th and go until March 15th.

Kempner Water Supply, the City of Lampasas and the City of Salado have chosen to implement a temporary disinfectant conversion to free chlorine based on the decision of Central Texas Water Supply Corp. to implement a free burn of their water system. During this period, you may experience taste and odor changes associated with this type of temporary disinfectant conversion.
