The Weather

Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies with gradual clearing and a high temperature near 81°. Wind will be S near 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph this afternoon.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies and the low temperature will dip to near 40°. Wind will be S at 10-20 mph shifting N-NW overnight with possible gusts of 30 mph.

Thursday: Mostly sunny skies with a high temperature near 52°. Wind will be N-NW near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

City Council Notes

The committee for the Solar Eclipse Event 2024 continues to meet and discuss potential issues surrounding the event on April 8th, 2024. Staff is currently in the process of gathering information to present to the citizens of Lampasas at the **town hall meeting scheduled for April 5th, 2023**. The Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Year-End Financial report shows an increase in utility fees and energy consumption towards the end of the year. "We had a good year considering some of the things we were going through," city manager Finley deGraf-fenried said. "Winter storm Uri and coming out of Covid-19. It's not back to normal, but it's kind of a new normal." A second reading of ordinances to add skate park rules, appropriate signage to the skate park, and the proposed 35 mph speed zone for Lampasas High School on Hwy 281 was approved unanimously. The city manager's operational report shows progress on the city's skate park. Staff remains optimistic the park can be completed by the end of February.

The Lampasas Police Dept. 2022 annual racial profiling report was discussed briefly. According to the report there were 3,348 total stops, 168 searches, 118 instances of discovered contraband, 2,298 written warnings, 896 citations, 46 arrests, and 0 racial profiling complaints. An ordinance to call the general election for May 6th to elect the expired terms of the mayor, council members places one, two, and six; and provide early voting, polling times, places, and bilingual election materials was approved unanimously. The appointment of two members of the Lampasas City Council plus the Mayor to a joint City-County committee to study impacts and planning of a relief route connecting US 281, US 183, and US 190 was discussed. Council member Herb Pearce and council member Chuck Williams were appointed to the joint committee.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on February 10th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 29 cases were brought to the court with 25 cases involving men and 4 cases involving women. (*cont'd on back*)

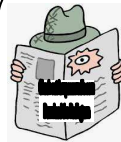

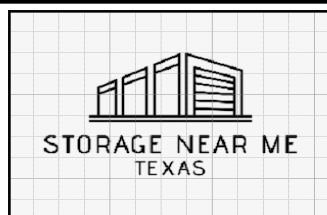

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Tuesday shows a report of a suspicious vehicle in the 700 block of E. 5th St. at 12:58am, a disorderly conduct was reported in the 300 block of N. The afternoon shows reports of suspicious persons: one in the 1100 block of Nix Rd. at 1:33pm and one in the 700 block of E. 5th St. at 3:21pm. Reports of suspicious vehicles came in from the 300 block of E. 4th St. at 7:24pm and from the 900 block of Campbell St. at 10:38pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter for Tuesday shows Kempner with a report of a missing person, a reported theft, medical calls, an accident, an alarm call and a juvenile problem. Out in the county there were reports of suspicious activity, civil matters, a report of illegal dumping, an accident, a reported identity theft, a repossession and animal issues. Deputies went into Cove on a shots fired call.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of a 40 year old Lampasas woman on 3 class C charges.

(cont'd from front) Michael Nelson of Austin failed to appear on the charge of Burglary of a Habitation, and Aubrey Rodgers of Lometa failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams.

There were 7 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 2 cases for possession less than a gram, 1 case for possession of 1-4 grams, and 3 cases for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 less than a gram. There was 1 DWI case.

There were 2 cases for burglary and 2 cases for theft. There was one case each for criminal mischief and one case for evading arrest.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 3 cases of injury to a child/elderly/disabled person, two cases of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and one case each of assaulting a public servant and assault of a pregnant person.

In other crimes there were 5 cases of possession w/intent to promote child pornography, and one case each of indecency with a child/sexual contact and continual sexual abuse/victim under 14.

Of the 29 cases, 3 were settled with Deirdre Wyss of Lampasas pleading no contest to theft of property w/2 or more previous convictions and receiving 3 years probation, as well as court costs and a \$1000 fine. Dakota Fralin saw one charge of aggravated

assault with a deadly weapon abandoned, and was sentenced to 5 years probation as well as court costs and a \$750 fine on the other count of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. Darrien Moore of Cedar Hill, Texas plead guilty and was sentenced to 3 years probation for theft of property/enhanced, as well as court costs and a \$750 fine.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
