City Council Notes

The committee for the Solar Eclipse Event 2024 continues to meet and discuss potential issues surrounding the event on April 8th, 2024. Staff is currently in the process of gathering information to present to the citizens of Lampasas at the town hall meeting scheduled for April 5th, 2023. The Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Year-End Financial report shows an increase in utility fees and energy consumption towards the end of the year. "We had a good year considering some of the things we were going through," city manager Finley deGraffenried said. "Winter storm Uri and coming out of Covid-19. It's not back to normal, but it's kind of a new normal." A second reading of ordinances to add skate park rules, appropriate signage to the skate park, and the proposed 35 mph speed zone for Lampasas High School on Hwy 281 was approved unanimously. The city manager's operational report shows progress on the city's skate park. Staff remains optimistic the park can be completed by the end of February.



The Lampasas Police Dept. 2022 annual racial profiling report was discussed briefly. According to the report there were 3,348 total stops, 168 searches, 118 instances of discovered contraband, 2,298 written warnings, 896 citations, 46 arrests, and 0 racial profiling complaints. An ordinance to call the general election for May 6th to elect the expired terms of the mayor, council members places one, two, and six; and provide early voting, polling times, places, and bilingual election materials was approved unanimously. The appointment of two members of the Lampasas City Council plus the Mayor to a joint City-County committee to study impacts and planning of a relief route connecting US 281, US 183, and US 190 was discussed. Council member Herb Pearce and council member Chuck Williams were appointed to the joint committee.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on February 10th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 29 cases were brought to the court with 25 cases involving men and 4 cases involving women. (cont'd on back)

There were 7 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 2 cases for possession less than a gram, 1 case for possession of 1-4 grams, and 3 cases for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 less than a gram. There was 1 DWI case.

There were 2 cases for burglary and 2 cases for theft. There was one case each for criminal mischief and one case for evading arrest.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 3 cases of injury to a child/elderly/disabled person, two cases of aggravated assault with w a deadly weapon and one case each of assaulting a public servant and assault of a pregnant person.

Darrien Moore of Cedar Hill, Texas plead guilty and was sentenced to 3 years probation for theft of property/enhanced, as well as court costs and a \$750 fine.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
