## The Weather

The High yesterday 76° The Low this morning 53°



Look for cloudy skies to give way to some sun later today, and with the southwesterly winds, it should be a very warm day with many of us getting into the low 80's. However...a cold front is entering the counties to the northwest of us this afternoon and should clear the area by the late evening hours today. Look for areas of light rain tomorrow and rain chances will increase as the week goes on. While rain rates should be fairly light, with rainfall expected in to Wednesday night, total rainfall amounts of 1 to 2 inches are likely in the Central Texas area.

**President's Day:** Mostly sunny with a high near 82°. S-SW wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Tonight:** The chance for showers at 20% after midnight with S winds at 5-10 mph shifting N. The low will be near 55°.

**Tuesday:** A 50% chance of rain and the high temperature will be near 61°. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Winds will be N at 15-20 mph, with 25 mph gusts possible There is a 40% chance of showers and the low temperature should be near 41°.

**Wednesday:** Cloudy skies and rain with a high near 50° and an 80% chance of rain. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Wednesday Night:** Rain probable (90% chance) with a low near 40°. Winds will be NE at 10 mph
