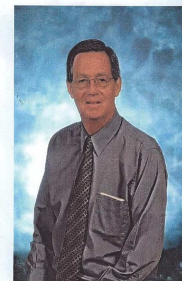

Museum to Showcase Local Musicians in Upcoming Exhibition

In its first exhibition of 2023, the Lampasas County Museum is celebrating the rich musical tradition in Lampasas County from its early days continuing through to the present. The exhibition, entitled *The Beat Goes On: Music in Lampasas County 1880 – 2023*, will begin with the 1880s when Lampasas was the social center of Texas, entertaining people from all over the state who came to stay at its grand hotels and enjoy the healing waters of its mineral springs. During that time and into the early 20th century, Lampasas could boast of four opera houses, four orchestras, three music schools and innumerable bands including its own marching band and its award-winning Municipal Band.

The exhibition continues with Cockeye Brown and His Aces, the go-to band for dances throughout Central Texas in the 1930s and 40s, the beginning of the Hayloft Party in the 1940s which is still going strong today, and the creation of the Lampasas radio station, KHIT (later KCYL) in 1948, which broadcast Lampasas County musicians to audiences across the state.

As for the large number of accomplished musicians working in Lampasas County today, the Museum will let them speak for themselves. Every Saturday afternoon during the exhibition through April 15, there will be live music at the museum at 1pm and again at 2pm, all performed by local musicians and all free of charge. At the time of this writing 19 different local musicians or groups had signed up to perform. The schedule, as it exists now, can be found

on the Lampasas County Museum's Facebook page. The Museum is open Fridays and Saturdays from 10am– 4pm and the exhibition runs through Saturday April 15.
