The Weather

The High yesterday 80° The Low this morning 63°



The forecasters say look for cloudy and cooler and some area will see showers and storms. The afternoon will bring falling temperatures and the north winds carry in the cooler air. Gusts could reach 30-35 mph. Rain chances are very good across Central Texas tonight. Tomorrow will feature rapid development of rain showers across the hill country during the morning hours. The rain, according to forecasters, will increase in coverage and intensity through the day.

Today: A 60% chance of showers and storms, with the greatest chances between 9am and noon. Winds will be shifting to the N at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph. The skies will remain cloudy and the temperature should fall to 44° by 5pm.

Tonight: A 60% chance of rain, and the temperature should hold at about 44°. The wind will be N at 15 mph gusting to 25 mph. The chance of showers increasing through the night.

Wednesday: Cloudy with a 100% chance of showers. The high temperature will be near 49°. Wind will be N-NE at 10 mph. Precipitation amounts of half an inch to three quarters of an inch possible.

Wednesday Night: The rain continues with a low near 38°. The wind will be N-NE at 5-10 mph.

Thursday: Cloudy with a high near 47°. Wind will be N-NE at 10-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly cloudy with N-NE wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. The low will be near 33°.

Early Voting Begins



Early Voting begins today for the primary election in Texas.

The Ballot includes choices for President, Representatives, Judges, and several propositions. In Lampasas County you can vote from 8am-5pm Monday through Friday, with the exception being the polls are open from 7-7 on Tuesdays. The location for early voting is 407 S. Pecan St. Ste 102.

Jury Trial Cancelled

The District Clerk has advised that The District Court Trial scheduled for February 24th has been Cancelled.

District Court Notes

Lampasas Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on February 14th. Presiding over the court was 27th District Judge John Gauntt. Bond was found insufficient for Michael Smith of Killeen on an assault of a family/household member/impeding breathing.

Altogether 23 cases were brought to the court. Nineteen of them involved men and 4 involved women. There were 7 cases involving possession of a controlled substance. 6 cases for less than a gram and 1 for 1-4 grams. There were 2 DWI 3rd or more cases. There was 1 felony case for burglary, one for fraud, and one for misappropriation of a trust fund. There was one case for theft under \$2500. There was one case for evading arrest. Crimes causing personal harm include 2 assault cases involving family members, one aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, and one aggravated assault. There was one case for online solicitation of a minor, one case of forcing sexual performance, and two aggravated sexual assault of a child. There was one case of failing to register as a sex offender.

Of the 23 cases presented to the court, one was decided with Amanda Hancock of Lampasas pleading guilty to theft of property less than \$2500 with 2 or more previous convictions. She was sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs. The balance of the cases were reset or had trials set for a future date.
