# The Weather



The High yesterday  $51^\circ$  The Low this morning  $36^\circ$  A 7-8 mph NE wind at daybreak made it feel pretty cool in Central Texas.

**Today:** Rain is very likely today, with the chance set at 80%. The day will be uncomfortable at best, probably not getting above  $41^{\circ}$  and that with enough NE wind to make it downright cold.

**Tonight:** A 20% chance of rain before midnight, then the clouds are thought to be dissipating a bit. The low should get down to about 34° the N-NE wind being thankfully very light and shifting a little to W-NW after midnight.

**Wednesday:** Mostly sunny with a high of around 61° and west wind 5-15 and gusting to 20. Overnight it will get back down to 39° as a second norther comes in.

**Rest of the week:** Thursday is going to cloud up with a high about 56° and easterly wind. Overnight a 40% rain chance shows up again. That rain chance increases to 50% on Friday and Friday night with temps in the 50s.

Saturday looks like a 40% rain chance and up to as much as  $70^{\circ}$  in the afternoon, and the clouds should clear up for the night and all the way through Sunday and Monday.

# The Snow Moon?

The stargazers should have all been out early this morning to see the biggest moon of all, the Super Snow Moon! It's a natural phenomena where the moon seems to be lined up in its orbit in such a way that it is closest to earth, and therefore a little bigger than at other times. The moon was supposed to be closest to earth at about 8am this morning, but it should still look pretty big tonight.
