The Weather

Today: Clouds in the area today but most of the rainy stuff appeared to have passed through about 9am. There is still a small chance of some rain early this afternoon. So.., cloudy and up to around 57° with calm wind turning to E-SE around 5 mph this afternoon.

Tonight: Patchy drizzle this evening (50% chance), areas of fog, and clouds are certain. The low should be about 48° with east wind turning to SW after midnight 5-15 mph.

Saturday: A 20% chance of a morning shower, then sunny with a high near 71°. Windy, with west wind 15-20 mph and gusting, and increasing to 25-30 before noon, and that could gust to as much as 40 mph. Overnight, the wind will again be strong, westerly for the most part, and the low should be in the upper 30s.

Sunday will be mostly sunny with a high near 60° and north wind will be light and turning to easterly.

Next week: Monday's long range forecast looks like a high of around 65 and light S-SE wind. Tuesday will be much the same, and it looks like a little warmer on Wednesday. Some rain chances appear late next week

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Friday shows an assault report on Ave. C at 12:08am. Much later, at 10:55am, there was a drug paraphernalia report in the 2700 block of Hwy 281S, then at 11:12am police were dispatched to the 800 block of Old Georgetown Rd on a domestic disturbance report.

The afternoon brought a criminal mischief report in the 1700 block of CTE at 1:39pm and an arrest in the 600 block of W. 3rd at 2:32pm where a 53 yr old Lampasas man was picked up on a County warrant for failure to appear on traffic warrants. A theft was reported in the 1100 block of E. Ave. F at 4:49pm and a reckless driver in the 500 block of S. Chestnut at 5:39pm.
