The Weather

Today: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 69°, then falling to near 59° for the rest of the day. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. Wind will shift to the N this afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy and the low temperature will dip to near 35°. There is a 20% chance of rain after midnight. Winds will be NE at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday: A 30% chance of rain or freezing rain before noon, then a slight chance of freezing rain. Look for cloudy skies and a temperature to fall to near 29° by 5pm. Wind will be N near 15 mph gusting to 20 mph. Little or no ice accumulation is expected.

Overnight Wednesday: A 40% chance of freezing rain, mostly early in the morning. Some thunder is also possible. Cloudy skies and a low near 26°. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Thursday: A 50% chance of rain or freezing rain, then rain chances decreasing with some thunder possible. Look for cloudy skies and a high near 38°. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Thursday Night: A 20% chance of rain, sleet and freezing rain after midnight. Skies will be mostly cloudy with a low near 24°. Wind will be N at 15 mph gusting to 25 mph

3rd St. Road Construction

From the City of Lampasas "The East 3rd Street Roadway Improvement Project construction commenced over three weeks ago in the City of Lampasas. This project addresses roadway improvements, as well as accessibility and connectivity from Key Avenue to South Western Avenue, the gateway into historic Downtown Lampasas. Expect delays and possible detours for the next month when traveling in this area of East 3rd Street. The proposed project is scheduled to be completed in mid-March, weather permitting. The contractual substantial completion date for this project is currently April 4, 2022.

Early Voting in Texas

Texans are heading to the polls for the 2022 primary, and voters will choose party nominees for statewide seats, including governor, and district-based congressional and legislative seats. Early voting lasts through Feb. 25, and election day is March 1. Historically, voter participation in midterm primary elections is dismal in Texas, with less than a quarter of registered voters casting ballots most years.

Turnout in the 2022 primary was low after the first four days of early voting. As of Feb. 17, the turnout data published by the Texas secretary of state does not reflect thousands of mail-in ballots reported by counties on their own websites. For instance, Fort Bend County reports that 1,400 mail-in ballots have been returned, but the state reports only two mail-in ballots there. In-person ballots are largely accounted for in the state's data. A spokesperson for the secretary of state said the office is aware of the discrepancies and working with counties to correct the information.

The party that draws more voters in Texas' open primaries is not a reliable indicator for who will win the general election in November. *(cont'd on back)*

Death Notices

Roy Lee Smith, 92, of Lampasas, passed away Sunday. Services will be held at First Street Church of Christ on Saturday at 2 pm with a visitation an hour prior. Interment will follow at Hurst Ranch Cemetery in Star.

“Turnout in the state for primary elections remains perpetually low. But this is true regardless of election year,” said Joshua Blank, the research director of the Texas Politics Project. “It’s not representative or indicative of what’s going to happen in the coming election cycle.”

In the 2020 presidential primary, more Democrats cast ballots than Republicans. But in November, Donald Trump won by 5.6 percentage points in Texas.

During the 2018 primary election, the state initially reported early voting data that showed more Democrats voted early than Republicans. But it was incomplete and when all counties were ultimately tallied; more Republicans had cast votes in the primary.

A law passed in 2019 requires all 254 counties to report who has voted early to the state, allowing the secretary of state to report more complete early voting counts.

Local Early Voting

Early voting started last Monday and as of the end of the day on February 18th, Lampasas has had a total of 1,304 ballots cast for the elections. This is a combination of mail-in and in-person ballots.

The early voting location is the election Office at 407 S. Pecan St., Ste 102 in Lampasas. You can vote today from 7am to 7pm, and Wednesday through Friday from 8am to 5pm.
