Commissioners' Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court will meet Monday February 28th in the Commissioner's Courtroom at the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, discussion of the TxDOT Hazardous Safety Improvement Program project at CR 3220 and CR 3371, discussion of an order designating a reinvestment zone for Triple B Solar LLC and Affiliates, the eclipse, racial profiling reports from the Lampasas Police Dept, Precinct 1 and the Sheriff's office, a letter of retirement from Constable Dennis James, and approval of the Hamilton County Inmate Housing Contract Agreement.

Candidates Debate

(Texas Tribune) On Thursday night, former state Supreme Court Justice Eva Guzman, Land Commissioner George P. Bush and U.S. Rep. Louie Gohmert, R-Tyler, will debate in Austin. Paxton's team declined to participate.

Each wants to unseat fellow Republican Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton in Tuesday's primary election, and they are all going on the attack in this final stretch of the campaign.

While Paxton is airing TV ads attacking Gohmert over his attendance record in Congress, and Gohmert is countering with his own commercial accusing Paxton of desperation, Bush is running TV ads targeting Guzman, who says Bush's claims are "ludicrous." Recent polls suggest Paxton will lead, but the hotly contested primary could go to a runoff. They are less clear on who he could face in an overtime round. (cont'd on back)



Lampasas Student Wins 2nd in San Antonio Calf Scramble

Jonathan Harris wins \$1400 for placing 2nd in the San Antonio Calf Scramble.

Jonathan Harris, son of Jon-Paul and Jennifer Harris, placed 2nd in the calf scramble competition at the San Antonio Rodeo on February 19th, 2022.

The San Antonio calf scramble is a competition open to 4-H and FFA

members between the ages of 12 and 18. Twenty-four participants are selected for each performance to compete. Twelve calves are then released into the rodeo arena, and the twelve scramblers who are able to catch a calf, put a halter on it, and lead it back to the circle win the event.

The winners of the event each earn a \$1200 scramble certificate to use to buy a breeding animal to bring back and show at the 2023 San Antonio Stock Show. The first, second, and third place winners earn \$1400.

Since Jonathan placed 2nd, he has been invited back as an alternate to the calf scramble finals on February 25th. If he is selected to compete, he is guaranteed an extra \$500, and has the opportunity to earn up to an additional \$1800.

Jonathan plans to use his scramble certificate to buy a registered breeding goat to show at the 2023 Lampasas County Youth Livestock Show and the 2023 San Antonio Stock Show.
