Lampasas Radio heard from Dr. Hay that Lampasas County has 2027 total cases, and 18 active, with 3 Lampasans in the hospital. The State of Texas saw 4,991 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 2,009 new probable cases. 6,738 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.
