The Weather



The High yesterday 70° The Low this morning 56° It was very foggy in Lampasas Co. overnight and at daybreak .

Today: The dense fog is expected to clear by late morning, then it will be partly sunny and up to perhaps 78° this afternoon. Light and variable wind will become SW at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: A 20% chance of showers after midnight, otherwise cloudy and down to about 40° with north wind 5-10 mph.

Thursday: Mostly cloudy and a 20% chance of rain. The high should be about 55° with that north wind 5-10. Overnight there could be drizzle after midnight and down to 43°. The north wind will shift to E-NE and turn calm.

Rest of the week: Friday could bring drizzle before noon, partly sunny then with a high near 75° and light wind becoming south at 5-10 in the morning.

Saturday looks like a 30% rain chance now, otherwise 50s in the morning and getting up to 63° in the afternoon. Overnight the rain chance gets up to 50% and the low drops into the upper 30s behind a 10 mph north wind.

Sunday rain chances are to 30% and the high hangs at about 47. The big note is that Sunday night is expected to bring a light freeze, dropping to what is believed to be about 29°. That kind of cold weather is expected to be around into Monday and Tuesday.

Lampasas Fire Chief Retires

Reece Oesterich, Current Fire Chief, former Fire Marshal, and 22 yr veteran of Lampasas FD is leaving. He is taking retirement, for which he is eligible now, but is reportedly taking another job as a State fire investigator.

A reception is planned for Chief Oestreich tomorrow at the Lampasas Fire Station. The public is invited to come by and wish him well at 2pm.

As to his replacement, according to City Manager Finley deGraffenried, the City will make the vacancy public and begin taking official applications for the job as Lampasas Fire Chief in the near future.



District Court Notes

Lampasas Courthouse was the site of a 27th District court docket Call on February 22nd. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Judge



John Gauntt. There were 17 cases presented by Lampasas County and City lawmen and the County Attorney's office. Altogether 17 cases were brought to the court. Fourteen of them involved men and three were women. There were six cases involving possession of a controlled substance. Felony cases for burglary, theft or robbery totaled two.

Eight cases were reset, with Billy Bruns on a charge of assaulting a public servant was set for Jury trial on April 15th, with a pre-trial appearance on April 5th for an additional charge of possession of a controlled substance.

Jose Gerardo Chaples-Bruzon of Las Vegas failed to appear on a charge of fraudulent used/possession of identifying information / items and his bond was increased to \$50,000 and a warrant was issued. Johnna Johnson of Burnet also failed to appear on a charge of fraudulent delivery of a controlled substance/ prescription schedule II, but it seems she is in the Burnet County Jail. However, bond was found insufficient, and her bondsman has contacted the court. Landon Bankston agreed on a modification of probation for a charge of possession of a controlled substance more than 4 grams but less than 400 grams. Ciara Phillips had her probation continued with SAFPF waived to continue private treatment.

Wesley Collins of Lampasas was sentenced to 20 years TDCJ plus costs and fees, with credit for time served for Sexual Assault of a Child. Joshua Ryan Diederich, also of Lampasas entered a plea of guilty to a class A misdemeanor for continuous violence against the family, and was sentenced to 2 years Deferred Adjudication Probation with a \$1000 fine plus court costs and attorneys fees. Cristjyn Joseph Tuma from Lampasas has entered a plea for Sexual Assault of a Child with sentencing to take place on March 15th.

A Contested Hearing will take place on April 12th at 9am for Michael Mutter, of Copperas Cove, who is charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance PG 1 less than a gram. The next Docket Call for Lampasas District Court is March 8, 2019.


