## The Weather



The High yesterday 49° The Low this morning 24°

After a cold morning, the SW winds and sunshine will bring temperatures to near 60° this afternoon. A cool front will move through the area late tonight and tomorrow. The only thing we may notice is the shift to light NW winds again this afternoon. It will be cool again, but not as cold as this morning. Saturday should warm up in the afternoon, and the National Weather Service advises there will also be an elevated threat of grass fires. Highs Sunday should be in the 70's and 80's, and caution is advised when burning Sunday as well.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 60°. The wind will be SW at 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Clear with a low around 34° and SW wind at 5-10 mph shifting NW after midnight.

**Friday:** Sunny with a high near 70°. Winds will be NW at 5 mph shifting to the S in the afternoon.

**Friday Night:** Winds will be S at 5 mph, and skies will be clear with a low of 42°.

**Saturday:** Warming up with mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 74°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph increasing to 15-20 mph in the afternoon gusting to 25 mph.

**Saturday Night:** 53° with partly cloudy skies, and S wind at 15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Sunday:** A high temperature near 79° with mostly sunny skies and S-SW wind at 15-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

## Trooper Talk on Lampasas Radio



**DPS Trooper Bryan Washko**, the Safety Education Sergeant for our area visited the Studio this morning for an on air talk show.

Sgt. Washko spoke about DWI arrests. He shared that while the .08% blood alcohol level is a standard, they also have contact with people that are under the influence of other substances, such as prescription drugs or illegal drugs. If that is the suspicion, those motorists are given the roadside sobriety test for evaluation. He states that we need to be aware of the side effects and warnings of prescription medications that we use.

He shared that the majority of people in our area appear to be using designated drivers, and the people who have been drinking are usually not driving.

Sgt. Washko also touched on the slow-down-move-over law that requires you to move over a lane and/or slow down and be prepared to stop if necessary. This include tow truck drivers and construction workers.

Also discussed was Steer It and Clear It: If you are involved in an accident and if there are no serious injuries and the vehicles can be driven, move them off the road to the nearest safe location; it's the law. After you are sure there are no injuries, get off the roadway then call 911. And finally, if you have a child safety seat that has been involved in an accident, it is recommended that you replace it.

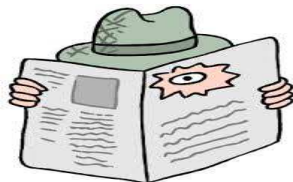

To obtain critical weather information, the National Weather Service (NWS) established SKYWARN® with partner organizations. SKYWARN® is a citizen volunteer program with between 350,000 and 400,000 trained severe weather spotters. SKYWARN® storm spotters are citizens who form the nation's first line of defense against severe weather. The SkyWarn class for Lampasas County will be next Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup> at the County Annex building from 6-8pm. The NWS does not require registration.
