City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet this afternoon for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion concerning the Hostess House Rehabilitation Project, and the 3 year projection of the Street Improvement Forecast.

The Regular Session will begin immediately following the Workshop Session (possibly prior to 6pm).

The Agenda includes the Consent Agenda to include the second reading of an Ordinance calling the May 6th 2023 General Election for the City of Lampasas to elect the expired terms of the Mayor and Council Members Places One, Two and Six. Also included on the Agenda are board and departmental reports, the City Manager's Operational Report to include information on a TxDOT TA Grant (for bicycle and pedestrian funding programs), a Downtown Grant and Rollins Brook Hospital.

In new business Council will discuss and take possible action regarding selection of a firm for the Hostess House Rehabilitation Project, approval for 2023 Annual Community Events, appointments of board members, discussion and possible action regarding the first reading of an Ordinance to add Swimming Pool Adult lap Fees to the Ordinances Fee Schedule, and discussion and possible action regarding approval of award of quote to RCN Technologies for 18 CradlePoint mobile routers for wireless connectivity in police patrol vehicles.

Council will then go into Executive Session to discuss the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment and duties of City Manager. Council will then return to regular session for action on items discussed in Executive Session.
