Other than a few high clouds in the Central Texas sky this morning look for a wind shift sometime before noon and a steady warm up into the 60's. Things will cool down tonight, but not as cool as this morning. Tomorrow looks to be a windy day with winds increasing. Tomorrow will see the temperatures in the 70's.

Today: Sunny and a high near 70°. Wind will be W at 5 mph becoming calm.

Last Day for Early Voting....

Today is the last day for early voting in the 2020 primary. The local election office says they are busy, but there is no wait. The next opportunity to vote will be on Super Tuesday.

Lampasas County, as of yesterday evening, has had 1438 early votes cast. Bell County has had 12,491 votes cast and Coryell County has had 4,394 early votes cast.

The Texas Tribune reports that as of Wednesday at total of 719,852 people have voted in person and by mail in Texas 10 largest counties. According to the Secretary of State, 57.2% of all Texas voters live in these 10 counties.

City Making New Water Connections



Lampasas Radio reached out to Rickie Roy of the City of Lampasas Public Works Dept. about the "Boil Water" notices left on some homes on the west side of Key Ave. Due to the new water line being implemented on west Ave. C, when the city switches a home from the old line to the new one, the water must be cut off. Any time the water is cut off a boil water notice must be issued. This is a TCEQ regulation. Mr. Roy said they try to reach all the homes affected, however, due to the age of the lines, and lack of mapping, sometimes homes are missed.

If your water goes off, **Boil your water before use.** Mr. Roy also asks that the resident call the city at 512.556.6831. This will also enable a better mapping of properties and the water lines that affect their home.

The replacement of the lines will be taking place for the next 2-3 weeks, and they are going by block or section. Again, call the City of Lampasas with any questions.

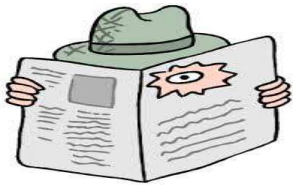
