The Agenda included the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, discussion of the TxDOT Hazardous Safety Improvement Program project at CR 3220 and CR 3371, discussion of an order designating a reinvestment zone for Triple B Solar LLC and Affiliates, the eclipse, racial profiling reports from the Lampasas

Police Dept, Precinct 1 and the Sheriff's office, a letter of retirement from Constable Dennis James, and approval of the Hamilton County Inmate Housing Contract Agreement
The Lampasas City Council will meet Today at 4:30pm for a workshop session, the agenda will include an update on the Covid 19 Pandemic, a specialized finance CO funding presentation, discussion about the comprehensive plan implementation, and the April Council Work session date.

The Regular session will begin at 6pm. The agenda includes the consent agenda There will be board and departmental reports, as well as the City Manager's report. In new business there will be discussion regarding extending fiber to the City Library by utilizing American Recovery Act Funds, discussion and possible action regarding the approval of funding for the new City Library sign, discussion about redesignating a portion of Highway 281 as US 281 business by resolution, discussion and possible action about a specific use permit for property described as 1900 Grand Canyon to allow for a garage/apartment/accessory structure. Discuss and consider approval of events and allocation of public safety resources for the 2022 special community events.

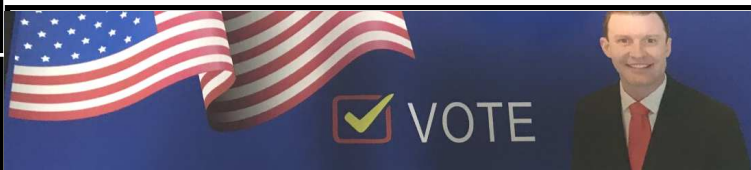
