The Weather



High yesterday was 71° Low this morning was 41°
Might be a bit gusty today, with southerly winds expected to start by late morning. Winds may gust to 25 mph. The south wind will bring a balmy day, especially for February. As the moisture returns, look for low temperatures to only drop into the 50's. Next week we may see some storms on Tuesday, with Central Texas being one of the most likely locations. The forecasters are still looking into things, but say that widespread rainfall totals between 1 and 2 inches are more likely with localized 3+ inches possible if the storms linger in one area.

Today: Mostly sunny with winds from the S at 5-10 mph, increasing to 15-20 mph in the afternoon with gusts as high as 25 mph. The high temperature will be near 72°.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with S winds at 15 mph gusting to 25 mph. The low will be near 55°.

Sunday: Partly sunny with a high temperature near 77°. S-SW wind at 15-20 mph., with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Sunday Night: A low temperature near 58° and partly cloudy skies. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Monday: Skies will be mostly cloudy with the high temperature near 75°. Wind will be S-SW at 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers.

Monday Night: A low near 56° and mostly cloudy skies with S-SW winds at 5 mph.

Tuesday: Looks like rain and a chance of storms, with a high temperature of 67°. Wind will be E shifting to the N early in the day. Precipitation chances are 80%.



The Blotter

The Lampasas Police Dept. Blotter for Friday shows a busy overnight with an early morning disturbance in the 1200 block of W. Badger Baseball

The Waco ISD Tournament goes into its final day today at Veteran's Baseball fields in Waco. The Badger Varsity team is 3-1 so far in that contest. They beat Little River Academy 6-1 on Thursday with the win going to Logan Coleman who went 4 innings, giving up 2 hits but no runs and striking out 5. After the first big win the Badgers lost a 5-4 squeaker to Groesbeck in a 7 inning contest. The game was well in control, 4-0 Badgers, going into the 6th inning. Marty Ybarra, the Badgers fast ball pitcher, had been on the mound and had given up no runs through 5 innings but there were hits and fielding errors and when Ybarra left the mound it was 4-3 Lampasas. Hunter Rebando took over the mound and soon another score at the bottom of the 6th and it was 4-4, sending the teams into inning 7. The Badgers couldn't get around the bases and it went to the bottom of the 7th with Groesbeck stealing home and taking the win 5-4.

In Friday's first contest, against Navasota, the Badgers overpowered their opponents, going through 3 pitchers in 4 innings. Ethan Rascoe was up first, striking out three in the first inning and giving up 1 single. In the Badgers' first at-bat, they scored 12 runs. In the second inning, with a huge lead, the Badgers put Tak Stinnett on the mound. He struck out 2, walked 1 and the third batter grounded out. The bottom of the 2nd saw five more Badger runs, including a homer by Uvalle. The third inning saw Stinnett pitch again with two ground outs and a strike out. The bottom of the 3rd brought another Badger score, totaling 18 at this point. The top of the 4th saw Stanley come in to pitch.

He hit a batter and sent him to 1st, then walked two in a rocky start. The next batter grounded out but brought a runner in for Navasota's first and only run before another groundout and a strikeout ended the game in a run rule 18-1 Badger victory.

In the second game, against Waco High, Ethan Rascoe went to the mound again for the standard 5 inning stint. He threw 73 pitches with 53% strikes, 6 strikeouts and 4 walks. He gave up no hits, 1 error and 2 runs. Rascoe was relieved by Jose Uvalle for the last inning. He struck out 2, gave up no hits and walked 2 in the close.

At bat in the Navasota game, Ace Whitehead took his usual 1 hole in the order and went 2 for 4 with 2 runs scored. Haydn Hammerschmidt was 1 for 3 and scored twice, Gauge Gholson was 1 for 3 and scored once and Jose Uvalle was 1 for 2. Today the Badgers' biggest challenge will come in a contest with a tough 5A Cleburne team at 12:30pm on Veteran's Field.
