The Weather

The High yesterday 65° The Low this morning 44°

Today: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 71°. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds with the low temperature near 53°, and a S wind at 10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph. The rain chances will continue in the night, then some clearing as the front exits the area.

Tuesday: The warming trend will continue with a high temperature near 74°. Skies will be mostly cloudy with S winds increasing in the afternoon to 15-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Tuesday Night: Cloudy with a low near 59°, and SS winds continuing near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

City Council Meets

The Lampasas City Council meets tonight for regularly scheduled sessions. The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and include discussion regarding updates related to the Covid pandemic, the Comprehensive Plan, a new IT Computer policy, and any item on the regular agenda.

The regular session agenda will include a proclamation of Fair Housing Month, a public hearing to receive comments regarding the Draft Comprehensive Plan, the consent agenda, discussion and possible action regarding the second reading of amending a Personnel Policy, board and department reports, routine matters to include the city manager's operational report, and mayor's comments. In new business discussion will take place concerning the following: services with Reliance Architecture LLC regarding the Hostess House rehabilitation project; an Interceptor Capacity Study proposal from Eckerman Engineering for \$35,250; awarding the contract for the 3rd St. Culvert and Paving project to M & C Fonesca for \$101,525; approval of payment of \$330,880.69 to Motorola for a communication system; a 5-year lease agreement for the City of Lampasas Water Dept. for a 2021 420XE CAT Backhoe and a 2021 308CAT Excavator in the amount of \$42,256.80 per year; and the first reading of an Ordinance to amend the use of technology/personnel policy. Council will then move into Executive Session for consultation with an attorney" relating to the authority of public power utility governing bodies to deliberate regarding competitive matters-Utilities", then move again in to Regular Session for action concerning the items discusses in executive session.

Commissioners' Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court met this morning in the Lampasas County Courthouse for a regularly scheduled meeting.

The Agenda items include a variance request for change of ownership for the Sunridge Development, it was approved unanimously. A surveyor reported that there were no significant drainage concerns with this project. The previous replat appeared to be unapproved from a previous year. Mr. Taylor, in court addressing the re-plat made the commissioners aware that the formalities of the previous replat were not addressed, comparing it to "like closing the gate after the cows have got out". Subject to application fees, the motion to replat was also approved unanimously.

The request for Gas and Diesel bids was addressed by commissioners. Bids typically have a fluctuating price for fuel, bid addresses the profit margin collected by the applicant. The commissioners voted unanimously to request bids.

The Lometa ISD was approved for \$20,117.29 of Cares Act Funds for reimbursement for COVID related expenses. Invoices were verified by the County Clerk. The commissioners voted unanimously to approve funds.

The 2021 Spring Ho resolution was addressed to set aside Court House Square for use. The Spring Ho festival will be held from July 5th-11th, 2021 It will include a carnival, live music, kiddie fishing derby, pet parade, craft fair, and more. More information regarding events can be found at Springho.com.

The Sheriff's office petitioned no action on the approval for contract for internet services with Suddenlink. Sheriff Ramos commented to the council that the department was currently in negotiations with AT&T to provide internet services. In addition, Sheriff Ramos commented that the department was in the process of moving administrative items from the previous jail. Sheriff Ramos expects that by the end of the month the transfer will be complete to the new facility.
