The Weather



The High yesterday 77° The Low this morning 42°

Today: Look for cloudy skies and an 80% chance of precipitation. The high temperature will be near 49°, and the wind will be blustery, near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph. The front responsible for the rain is moving slower than expected, and the possibility of heavy rain will continue in Central Texas.

Tonight: Cloudy skies with the low temperature near 38°, and a N wind at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph. The rain chances will continue in the night, then some clearing as the front exits the area.

Tuesday: Sunny with a high near 59°, and N winds at 5-10 mph.

Tuesday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 36°, courtesy of the mostly clear skies and light winds.

Lampasas ISD School Board Meeting Tonight

The Lampasas ISD School Board has a regular meeting scheduled for this evening at the Lampasas ISD administration building at 6pm. The agenda includes the consent agenda, which includes a second reading of policy updates, notification of resignation for professional personnel, a budget amendment, new contract forms, a missed school day waiver, a remote only instructional day waiver and a change of date of the April School Board Meeting. Also included on the agenda is a list of bills, an order declaring election of unopposed candidate, Superintendent's recommendations, administrative reports to include a campus report from Lampasas Middle School, and possible consultation with attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

This from Lampasas County Emergency Management Coordinator;

Lampasas County is partnering with Bell County to receive 200 doses of COVID-19 vaccine each week. The vaccine will arrive starting the week of March 1, 2021 and will be divided between two medical facilities, AdventHealth Family Medicine Rural Health Clinic and AdventHealth Rollins Brook Hospital.

Lampasas County's Local Health Authority Dr. Georgia Hay is working to receive more doses of vaccine from the Texas Department of State Health Services to provide vaccine for the Seton Lampasas Healthcare Center Clinic, but does not currently have any vaccine available at this time.

Lampasas County would like to Thank Bell County for partnering with us so our citizens can start receiving the COVID-19 vaccine.

The vaccine is available to:

- Phase 1a – Front-line healthcare workers and long-term care facilities.
- Phase 1b – People over 65 or people 16+ with a health condition that increases risk of severe COVID-19 illness, including but not limited to: Cancer, Chronic kidney disease, COPD, Down Syndrome, Heart Conditions, Organ transplantation, Obesity, Pregnancy, Sickle disease, Type 2 diabetes. If you have a medical condition not listed above, you may still qualify for the vaccine. Talk to your provider to confirm.
