Voting in Texas

Texans are heading to the polls today for the 2022 primary, and voters will choose party nominees for statewide seats, including governor, and district-based congressional and legislative seats. Historically, voter participation in midterm primary elections is dismal in Texas, with less than a quarter of registered voters casting ballots most years.

Locally, Lampasas County has primaries for local candidates. Some do not have opponents, but the County Clerk primary has contenders Dianne Miller, Dee Ann Crawford, and Tasha Bates. The race for Justice of the Peace precinct one also has 3 contenders, Misty Wakeman, Dr. James Mercer and Chris Munn. State representative for district 68 has 4 contenders in the primary, Craig Carter, Gary Franklin, David Spiller and Mark Middleton. On the democratic ballot, other than the state races, District 24 State Senator has 2 in the race with Jeremy Kohlwes and Kathy Jones-Hospod.

District Court Notes

The Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on February 25th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 52 cases were brought to the court with 37 cases involving men, and 15 cases involving women.

Jacqueline Jo Pickard failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG 1/1-4 grams. There were 10 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 6 cases for less than a gram, and 4 cases for 1-4 grams. There were two cases for possession of a controlled substance PG 2 less than a gram. There were also 2 cases for possession of PG 1-B (fentanyl) less than a gram. There was one case each for engaging in organized criminal activity, fraud, prohibited substance in a correctional facility, bail jumping/ FTA and one case for escape while arrested. There were 2 cases each for forgery, and unauthorized use of a motor vehicle. There were 4 cases each for evading arrest, theft of property and tampering w/a government record. There were 5 burglary cases.

In cases causing bodily harm, there was 1 case each for intoxication assault, intoxication manslaughter, continuing violence against family, deadly conduct (discharging a firearm), and stalking. There were 4 cases of assault of a family member. *(cont'd on back)*
