District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on February 24th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 47 cases were brought to the court with 38 cases involving men and 9 cases involving women.

There were 13 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 7 cases for possession less than a gram, 3 cases for possession of 1-4 grams, and 1 case for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams, and one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 equal to or more than 400 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG2 equal to or more than 400 grams. There were 3 DWI cases.

There were 4 cases of tampering with government documents and 4 burglary cases. There were 3 cases for evading arrest, and 2 cases each for criminal mischief, engaging in organized criminal activity, theft and bail jumping/failure to appear. There was one case each for tampering with evidence, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon, and fraud.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was 1 case of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon.

In other crimes there were 2 cases each of soliciting a person under 18 years of age and aggravated sexual assault of a child. There was 1 case of sexual assault of a child and 1 case for failure to comply as a sex offender.

Of the 47 cases, 5 were settled with Douglas Faught being sentenced on 2 cases of solicitation/prostitution/person under 18 years of age. He was sentenced to 2 years probation plus court costs on each charge. Nathan Shuford, on the charge of manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG2 equal to or greater than 400 grams, was sentenced to 10 years probation with the stipulation of attending ISF plus court costs. On the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG 1 1-4 grams, James Teer of Houston plead guilty and was sentenced to 5 years probation, court costs and a \$1000 fine. Raymond Reyna plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams, saw his probation adjudicated and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ with credit for time served.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.

In Lampasas Radio Studios

Ryan Ward, Assistant Lampasas City Manager, visited with Ronnie Witcher this morning at Lampasas Radio. He updated listeners about the Hostess House Rehabilitation. There were 2 bidders, who both came in over budget, and the subject was tabled by City Council. Meanwhile the City will try to find out why the bids were so high, and review the costs, and perhaps do a redesign or reduce the scope of the project. We should have an update in 30-60 days.

He shared that they are looking to repave 2nd St. from Main St. – Pecan St. and will be going out for bids in about a year.

Mr. Ward also shared that the City's Collection Center will be closed next week as they are doing some upgrades. They may be open next Saturday. He said to bring a recent utility bill and a picture ID to drop items off at the Collection Center.
