## The Weather

The high yesterday 51° This morning's low 38°



**Today:** Today will be sunny with a high temperature near 60°, and winds will be N at 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Clear with a cool night and a low near 36°.

## District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Special Setting on February 25th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt.

Altogether 36 cases were brought to the court with 30 cases involving men, and 6 cases involving women. Domonique Gatlin, of Bellmead failed to appear on a charge of burglary of a habitation

There were 15 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1; there were 11 cases for possession less than a gram, including one in a drug free zone. There were three cases for possession 1-4grams, and 1 case for possession of 4-200 grams PG1. There was one case involving possession of a controlled substance/PG2, less than a gram. There were 2 cases for evading arrest w/a vehicle, 2 for burglary, and one for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle. There was one case each for theft \$2500-\$30,000, Hindering a secured creditor, debit abuse, tampering w/evidence and animal cruelty. There were 3 cases for engaging in organized criminal activity. Crimes involving personal harm included two cases for injury to a child/elderly/

disabled, 1 assault case, and one case each for solicitation/prostitution of a child under 18 years of age, sexual assault of a child, abandoning/endangering a child and continuous violence against family.

One case was settled with Shannon Reid of Lampasas sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs on the charge of continuous violence against the family.

**A second District Court Special Setting** took place on February 26<sup>th</sup>. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt.

Altogether 22 cases were brought to the court with 17 cases involving men, and 5 cases involving women. Johnny Morris, of Copperas Cove failed to appear on a charge of sexual abuse/continuous w/victim under 14. A warrant was issued.

There were 5 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1; there were 2 cases for possession less than a gram there was one case for possession 1-4grams, and 2 cases for possession of 4-200 grams PG1. There was one case involving possession of a controlled substance/PG2, less than a gram, an don e case involving PG 3 & 4, 200-400 grams. There was 1 cases for evading arrest w/a vehicle, 2 for burglary, and one for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle. There were 4 cases for tampering w/ a government document w/intent to defraud or harm, and one case for forgery. There was one case each for theft \$2500-\$30,000, There was 1 cases for engaging in organized criminal activity. Crimes involving personal harm included 2 aggravated assault cases, and one case for intoxication assault, two for indecency w/child/sexual contact, and one case for continuous sexual abuse of a child under 14.

Two cases were settled with Stephanie Liscum of Copperas Cove seeing her aggravated assault w/ a deadly weapon charge reduced to a misdemeanor and was sentenced to court costs, a fine and 1 day in county jail/credit time served. Adrian Navarro plead guilty to Indecency w/ a child/sexual contact and was sentenced to 5 years TDCJ w/credit for days served and court costs.

All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials.

## Funeral/Death Notice

Raymond C. Chapman, 86, passed away on Monday, March 1, at his residence in Kempner surrounded by his loving family. Visitation will be held from 5pm to 7pm. on Thursday, March 4, at Sneed Funeral Chapel. Funeral Services will be at 11:30am on Friday, March 5 at Sneed Funeral Chapel. Interment with military honors will be held at 2pm Friday, March 5, at Central Texas State Veterans Cemetery in Killeen, Texas. Ray was born August 29, 1934, in Fort Worth, TX to Thomas Arthur and Pearl Mae Chapman. He faithfully served his country in the United States Marine Corps and United States Army. During the Korean War, he was part of the 1st Marine Division and during the Vietnam War; he was part of the US Army 12th Signal Group. He received many honors during his time in the military; two Bronze Stars, Army Commendation Medal, Korea, and Vietnam Service Medal with three campaign stars, and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry. After his retirement from the United States Army as an SFC, he was a police officer with Copperas Cove Police Department for 8 years, a police officer with the Lampasas Police Department for 12 years, and the remainder of his law enforcement career was spent with the Lampasas County Sheriff's Office. During his tenure in law enforcement, he was awarded the Copperas Cove Police Officer of the Year by the Knights of Columbus and was also awarded the Lampasas Police Officer of the Year.

Ray also served as a Troop Leader for the Boy Scouts, enjoyed his RC planes, and was an avid fisherman. He was also a member of Kempner Oak Hills Baptist Church where he held positions as Deacon, Trustee, Treasurer, Royal Ambassador Leader, CLEAT (Combined Law Enforcement Associations of Texas), NRA, and was an associate member of the Sheriff's Association of Texas. He was preceded in death by his parents; Thomas Arthur and Pearl Mae Chapman, his sons; Darren Jay Chapman, Douglas Wade Chapman, and Lorne Alen Chapman, his brothers; Edward and Vyron Chapman, and sisters; Pauline Farrell and Virginia Sullivan.

Survivors include his wife of 67 years, Bobbie Chapman of Kempner. Son; Greg Chapman and wife, Debbie of Kempner, daughter; Cyndi Stone and husband, Stephen of Kempner, brother; Byron Chapman and wife, Carol, grandchildren; Ashley Mellon of Conroe, Jackie Hanke of Sharp, Adam Chapman of Austin, Logan Chapman of Copperas Cove, James K. Imhoff of Kempner and five great-grandchildren.
