Election Results

The primary election took place yesterday and there were 3 local contested races. In the County Clerk primary election, Dianne Miller took the most votes with 1,871 votes, Dee Ann Crawford with 1,649 votes and Tasha Bates had 397 votes. In the Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 race, Misty Wakeman took 54% of the vote with 1057 votes, followed by Dr. James Mercer with 590 votes and Chris Munn with 300 votes. In the Justice of the Peace Precinct 4 election, Dan Hause received 62.22% of the vote or 904 votes, Gilbert Esparza receive 312 votes or 21.47% and Matilde Uvalle Werlinger with 16.31% of the votes (237). August Pfluger won for Republican US representative, District 11 (he was running unopposed). For Republican State Senator District 24, Pete Flores was the winner with 2,168 votes or 57.48%, with Paul Reves receiving 1,024 votes and Lamar Lewis receiving 580 of the votes. On the democratic side of State Senator District 24, Kathy Jones-Hospod (with 324 or 74.14% of the vote will be in the race with Pete Flores. In Republican State Representative District 68, David

Spiller came out on top with 52.64% of the vote, or 1,911 votes. Spiller defeated Craig Carter (565 votes), Gary Franklin(707 votes) and Mark Middleton (447 votes) in that race.

Other local offices that were on the ballot but were uncontested were on the Republican side, County Judge, District Clerk, County Treasurer, County Surveyor, County Commissioner Precinct 2, County Commissioner Precinct 4, Justice of the Peace Precinct 2, County Constable Precinct 4, and county chair. The democratic County Chair also ran unopposed.

Statewide, for the Republicans, Greg Abbott (2800 votes)won the nomination for Governor. Beto O'Rourke won the nomination for the Democrats (419 votes). For the Lieutenant Governor, Dan Patrick took the ticket for the Republicans (2,784 votes), and Mike Collier had the most votes on the Democratic ticket (181 votes). Ken Paxton (Republican) won the most votes for attorney general (1,921) and will face George P. Bush (854 votes) in a runoff election , and Rochelle Garza took 42.7% of the votes (190) for the Democrats for the office of Attorney General.

Fire in Lampasas

The Lampasas Fire Department as well as the Kempner and Lometa Fire Departments responded to 1704 CR 1025 yesterday afternoon at 2:14pm. The call was initially for a grass fire, but by the time the fire departments were on scene, the fire had moved in to a structure. There is some heat damage to another outbuilding, but the main house was not involved in the fire.
