Runoff Elections

The Lampasas County Clerk race will be having a runoff election . Dianne Miller (with 1,871 or 47.77% of the votes) and Dee Ann Crawford (with 1,649 or 42.1% of the ballots cast) will be engaged in a runoff election on May 24^{th} of this year.

In the statewide and district races for the Republicans, the race for Texas Attorney General will have a runoff between Ken Paxton (1,921 or 48.99% of the votes) and George P. Bush (854 or 21.78% of the votes). For the Railroad Commission, Wayne Christian (1,171 or 34.4% of the votes), will take on Sarah Stogner (730 or 21.45% of the votes) in May.

On the democratic ballot, Mike Collier (181 or 40.49% of the votes) will run against Michelle Beckley (166 or 37.14% of the votes) for a spot on the Lieutenant Governor's ballot. For the Democratic attorney general, Rochelle Garza (190 or 42.70% of the votes) will take on Mike Fields (81 or 18.2% of the votes). For the Democratic Comptroller of Public Accounts, Janet Dudding (203 or 46.24% of the votes) will go up against Angel Vega (149 or 33.94% of the votes), and in the Democratic Commissioner General Land Office race, Sandragrace Martinez (128 votes or 29.02%) will run against Jay Kleberg (with 118 votes or 26.76%). And for the Democratic Justice, 3rd Court of Appeal District, place 4, Rosa Theofania (162 votes or 37.33% will runoff against Beth Payan (149 or 34.33% of the votes).

Texas Primary Election

Around 17% of registered voters in Texas cast a ballot in the 2022 primary, according to preliminary turnout data from the secretary of state. As of Wednesday evening, 434 of Harris County's nearly 1,200 precincts had not reported their votes to the state. These turnout numbers also do not include the thousands of mail ballots that have been flagged for possible rejection because they don't comply with a new voting law. Voters have until six days after the election to correct their ballot. During the 2020 primary, mail-in ballots comprised 10% of the early vote.

Voters chose party nominees for statewide seats, including governor, and district-based congressional and legislative seats. Early voting was from Feb. 14 to Feb. 25, and election day was March 1. Nearly 55% voted early and 45% voted on election day. Historically, voter participation in midterm primary elections is dismal in Texas, with less than a quarter of registered voters casting ballots most years. This means that a majority of registered voters don't participate. These figures also do not account for the eligible voters in the state that have not registered.

"Turnout in the state for primary elections remains perpetually low. But this is true regardless of election year," said Joshua Blank, the research director of the Texas Politics Project. "It's not representative or indicative of what's going to happen in the coming election cycle."

Primary voters tend to be more engaged in politics compared with the rest of the electorate, whether that involves news consumption or engagement with civic organizations, according to Blank.

TikTok Investigation

WASHINGTON (AP) — State attorneys general have launched a nationwide investigation into TikTok and its possible harmful effects on young users' mental health, widening government scrutiny of the wildly popular video platform.

The investigation was announced Wednesday by a number of states led by California, Florida, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Nebraska, New Jersey, Tennessee and Vermont.

Last month, Texas opened an investigation into TikTok's alleged violations of children's privacy and facilitation of human trafficking. "Our children are growing up in the age of social media — and many feel like they need to measure up to the filtered versions of reality that they see on their screens," California Attorney General Rob Bonta said in a news release. "We know this takes a devastating toll on children's mental health and well-being."

Bonta said the investigation aims determine if TikTok is violating the law in promoting its platform to young people.
