## The Weather

The High yesterday 40°  
The Low this morning 23°  
The north wind was gusting to 23 mph from 2-5am.



**Today:** Cloudy early, then sunny, with a high of only 33° and with that occasional 10-15 and gusting to 20 mph north wind. Bundle up!

## Senate to Vote on Teacher Pay Raise



The Texas Senate is to vote on SB 3 today that would provide an additional \$3.7 billion for Texas Public Schools. That follows a House bill that would provide \$7 billion for public education.

The Senate bill would require all schools use the additional funding specifically to give all Texas teachers a \$5,000 pay raise. There are pros and cons to the issue, schools might regard the issue as another "mandate" that would have legislators deciding how schools use their funds. Some schools may have other needs that they feel are crying for more funding. Teachers, on the other hand, might welcome a pay raise and feel it is long time coming.

School funding, an issue that has been argued and maligned and changed back and forth for many years will undoubtedly see some kind of change at the hand of our legislators this year...for better or worse.

# The Blotter

The afternoon brought 2pm criminal mischief report in the 500 block of S. Western. At 4pm, police were on the 700 block of S. Key where they arrested a 41 yr old Lampasas man for driving with an invalid license and no liability insurance.

At 6:32am there was a disturbance in the 800 block of N. Ridge St. The blotter for Sunday showed five arrests. It started at 12:56am with the arrest of a 17 yr old Lampasas girl, picked up in the 900 block of S. Key for possession of marijuana.

At 3:11am, there was a double arrest in the 100 block of N. Key Ave. An 18 yr old Lampasas male was charged with unlawful use of a criminal instrument and for unlawful carrying of a weapon. A second arrest in this case was on a 17 yr old Kempner male, charged with the same unlawful use of a criminal instrument and carrying of a weapon.
