The Weather



The high yesterday 71° This morning's low 42°
Today: Sunny skies with a high temperature 5-15 degrees above normal, near 75° and winds will be S near 5-15 mph gusting to 25 mph. The National Weather Service expected winds to increase during the day and there will be an elevated threat for grass fires west of I35.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds and a low temperature near 51°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.
Friday: Partly sunny with gradual clearing, and a high near 76°. Wind will be SW at 10-15 mph shifting W-NW at 15-20 mph, gusting to 30 mph

Overnight Friday: Partly cloudy skies with N winds at 15-20 mph and possible gusts to 30 mph.

Saturday: Partly sunny with a high temperature near 63°. Winds will continue from the N at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Saturday Night: A low near 46° and mostly cloudy skies. Winds will be light from the SE.

After the short lived cool front over the next few days, above normal temperatures are expected for the first part of next week.

Followed by an opening prayer by Reverend Paul Hudson, the US Pledge, The Texas Pledge and keynote speakers that included Lampasas County Judge Randy Hoyer, Texas State Representative Brad Buckley's District Director, Jessica Menking Diem, and Texas Commission on Jail Standards Executive Director Brandon S. Wood.

The ceremony was then concluded with a ribbon cutting and was followed by a tour of the new center located at 1210 Barnes Street, Lampasas, Texas. It will function as the new County Sheriff's Office and Jail.

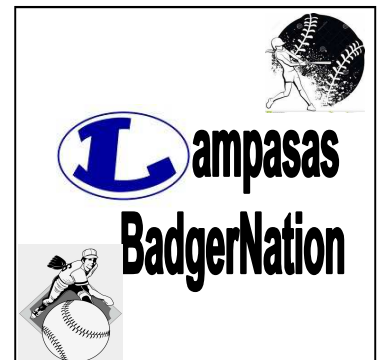

Coronavirus Update

Lampasas Radio heard from Dr. Hay that Lampasas County has 2054 total cases, and 13 active, with 2 Lampasans in the hospital with long term issues. Dr. Hay shared that the state has more deaths attributed to Lampasas County, and will know more on Friday when more data becomes available.

On the upside...Dr. Hay shared that Walmart will be offering the Johnson & Johnson vaccine soon. To schedule an appointment, residents are required to either have or register for a Walmart.com account. Then residents are advised to go to walmart.com/covid vaccines, and follow the prompts. The pharmacist at our local Walmart said they are working on a phone sign up for residents with no access to internet. The State of Texas saw 4,781 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 1,400 new probable cases. 5,508 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.
