The Blotter



The Lampasas Police Dept. Blotter for Friday shows a disorderly conduct reported in the 600 block of N. Key Ave. at 3:02am and a minor accident in the 1000 block of W. 1st St. at 7:43AM. The afternoon shows a minor accident at the intersection of 4th St. and Key Ave. at 2:17pm. There was a noise complaint in the 2300 block of 281S at 3:59pm, a criminal trespass was reported in the 600 block of S. Chestnut St. at 5:41pm and suspicious activity was reported in the 100 block of S. Arnold St. at 7:55pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dep. Blotter for Friday shows Lometa with reports of suspicious activity. In Kempner there was a noise complaint, medical calls, reported threats and civil matters. Out in the county there was an accident, civil matters, animal issues, a sex offense, reports of suspicious activity and requested welfare checks. Deputies went into Cove for an impound of a vehicle and animal issues.

(cont'd from front) We caution public to avoid purchasing vehicles over social media websites. Increasingly, we see criminals applying convincing but fraudulent VIN plates and stickers to stolen vehicles. They then advertise those for sale on social media for cash using fictitious online profiles. At the time of the sale they may present a fake ID and may even have a forged title to the vehicle. After the suspect has the cash, they disappear. The buyer is left with a vehicle that will be confiscated from them when the fraudulent VIN is ultimately discovered during the titling process.

This scheme has been seen time after time across Central Texas. The stolen vehicles have mostly been higher-end vehicles like the Chevrolet Silverado High Country, GMC AT-4, GMC Denali, along with the Ford Super Duty, King Ranch and Platinum pickups. These vehicles are most often stolen easily because careless owners have left their key-fobs in the vehicle. This means that the stolen vehicle will not exhibit any of the tell-tale damage that is traditionally present on vehicles stolen by older methods.

When the prices are too good to be true, stop and do more research. You can check the vehicle's VIN through TxDMV.gov. Many times this scheme may be avoided by asking the seller meet you with the title at a local tax office so that the title transfer can be done immediately. A seller who demands cash and is unwilling to meet at a tax office is very likely to be a scammer.
