The Weather



The High yesterday 57° The Low this morning 44°

A cool front will move across Central Texas this evening, reinforcing the northerly winds and keeping the high temperature cooler tomorrow. Clear skies tonight will allow low temperatures to fall in to the mid 30's to low 40's. Highs tomorrow should be in the 60's with light NE breezes.

Today: Sunny with a high near 70°. The wind will be NW at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low around 43° and N wind at 5 mph.

Friday: Sunny with a high near 63°. Winds will be N at 5-10 mph shifting to the E in the afternoon.

Friday Night: Winds will be E-SE at 5 mph, and skies will be partly cloudy with a low of 41°.

Saturday: Partly sunny skies and a high temperature near 66°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph.

Saturday Night: 48° with partly cloudy skies, and S-SE wind at 10 mph.

Sunday: A high temperature near 67° with mostly cloudy skies and S-SW wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

LPD Stepping up DWI Efforts



Lampasas Radio received a press release from Lt. Charles Montgomery of the LPD concerning the "Plan While You Can" campaign:

"AUSTIN – Spring Break can be a dangerous time for alcohol-related crashes, deaths and injuries on Texas roadways. During last year's Spring Break* in Texas, there were 417 crashes involving young drivers who were driving under the influence of alcohol. Those crashes killed 26 people and seriously injured another 52.

In response, Lampasas Police Department and law enforcement officers across Texas will increase DWI patrols to identify and stop impaired drivers as part of the Texas Department of Transportation's "Plan While You Can" campaign. The campaign aims to decrease crashes and save lives by urging drivers to plan a sober ride prior to driving to their spring break celebrations. The increased enforcement begins March 6th and runs through March 23rd.

"We urge young drivers to make responsible choices during the Spring Break holiday," said Chuck Montgomery, Patrol Lieutenant. "Before heading out, plan ahead for a sober ride. It's a decision that can save a life."

While drivers under the influence of alcohol risk killing or seriously injuring themselves or others, they also face up to \$17,000 in fines and fees, jail time and loss of their driver's license. Lampasas Police Department and TxDOT strongly

encourage everyone to plan for a sober ride before the celebrations begin. Visit SoberRides.org to find alternatives to drinking alcohol and driving, such as:

- Designate a sober driver.
- Calling a cab or ride-share service.
- Use mass transit.
- Asking a sober friend or family member for a ride.
- Spend the night.

"Plan While You Can" is a key component of #EndTheStreakTX, a broader social media and word-of-mouth effort that encourages drivers to make safer choices while behind the wheel, like wearing a seat belt, driving the speed limit and never driving after drinking or using other drugs. Nov. 7, 2000 was the last deathless day on Texas roadways. #EndTheStreakTX asks all Texans to commit to driving safely to help end the streak of daily deaths on Texas roadways."



Bypass Closed Today!

Lampasas Radio received the following email from TxDot about the bypass being closed today:
"The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will temporarily close the I-14/US 190 Valley Bridge in Copperas Cove, Thursday, March 5, 2020.

The temporary closure will allow TxDOT to remove temporary barrier and replace bridge railing damaged from a crash several months ago. All eastbound and westbound I-14 traffic will detour through Copperas Cove via Business 190 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Motorists can expect some congestion and temporary delays during the repair process"

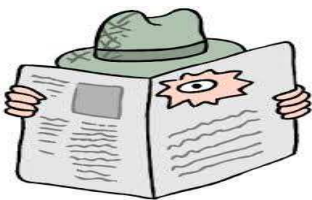
