**Today:** Sunny skies and a high near 74°. Winds will be W at 10-15 mph shifting to the N-NW and increasing to 15-20 mph in the afternoon with possible gusts of 30 mph.

## New Traffic Signal at 190 & FM 2808

**LAMPASAS COUNTY** – The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) installed and activated a new signal Thursday, March 4<sup>th</sup> at the intersection of US 190 and FM 2808 in Lampasas County. Currently the signal is temporarily programmed to flash yellow (caution) for US 190 lanes and red (stop) for FM 2808.

Crews also installed advanced flashing beacons on US 190 and activated these signs to alert the traveling public of the upcoming signal. New illumination was installed and activated. These will be on for 48 hours before running them with sensors.

Message boards are being used at each end of US 190 to advise motorists of the new signal. These boards also note the signal will be programmed to begin full operation on March 11<sup>th</sup>.

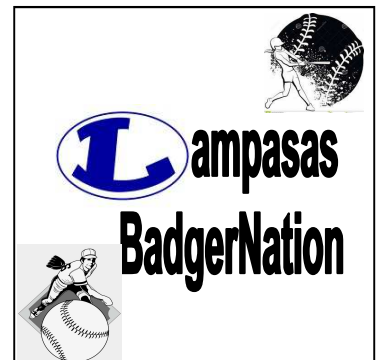
