High yesterday was 56° The low this morning was 48°

Today: Mostly sunny skies with a high of 73°. The wind becomes S-SW at 10-15mph, gusting to 20 mph.

Boil Water Notice for Lampasas

Lampasas radio has learned that an 18" water line on Spring St. was damaged causing a water main break. This being the case, the city of Lampasas was required to issue a Public Notice to Boil Water. The notice was sent out by the City of Lampasas, and includes water used for drinking, cooking, making ice as well as washing hands, brushing teeth, drinking etc. The notice also states that those with weakened immune systems may be particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria and it is especially important those individuals, as well as all other residents boil their water for a minimum of 2 minutes at a vigorous rolling boil before using.



The city of Lampasas moved fast on this and has already fixed the pipe. Workers replaced a 20 foot span of aged pipe to repair the line.

A sample of the water has been sent off for testing and results are expected back sometime Friday. The City will let residents know when the boil water notice has been lifted.

In the meantime the schools are in regular session, using bottled water for cooking, and local restaurants and convenience stores are limiting their menus and beverages until the city rescinds the boil water notice.
