## The Weather

The forecasters say high clouds will be expected through mid-day, and a sprinkle is not ruled out this afternoon. Look for the breezy S-SE winds to bring in some moisture from the Gulf of Mexico by Sunday.

## Meetings Monday

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court has a regular meeting at 9am at the Lampasas County Courthouse. The agenda includes the consent agenda, a grant application for Lampasas County Volunteer Fire Dept. Radio Project, Awarding bids for asphalt and emulsion, and for professional lawn care & grounds maintenance. There will be a request bid for Non Spec/Spec Flex Base, Racial profiling reports from area law enforcement agencies, a traffic survey for CR 2315 and CR 2337 for a speed limit decrease. There is request an approval to go out for bids for Asphalt Reclaimer and discussion about closing a portion of CR 1716. Central Texas Council of Governments will discuss some 911 addressing and there will be discussion of appointment of director to the board of the Central Texas Housing Finance Corp.

At 10:30am there will be an informational meeting on the progress of construction of the new law enforcement center. This meeting will be held at the new law enforcement center at 1210 Barnes St. This is NOT an official called meeting however a quorum may be present. No county business will be conducted.



At 1:30pm there will be a called meeting in the Annex conference room to discuss a department head.

The Lampasas City Council will meet in a workshop session Monday at 5:30pm for discussion and updates regarding the 2020 City Council Work Plan, Cooper Spring Trail Grant, and the Chamber of Commerce 1<sup>st</sup> quarter report.

In the regular session there will be public hearings, one regarding 208 E. 5<sup>th</sup> St., which will receive comments regarding rezoning form Retail to Single Residential Family, then concerning a SUP to allow for a garage apartment in an area zoned single residential family. The second will be regarding a SUP to allow for Portable Building Sales in an area zoned commercial. The 3<sup>rd</sup> will be concerning the rezoning of what is known as 707 S. Pecan St. The public hearings will include the rezoning of the tracts from Light Industrial to Multi-family residential (apartments).

Then the city will receive comments regarding amendments to the text of the City Zoning Regulations: planned development requirements to allow minimum tract area of 2 acres for a single podium structure, to define a podium structure as a multi-occupancy, multi-use horizontally separated building typically with more intense land uses on the lower floors and multi-family residential on the higher floors. Other combinations of land uses may be considered as part of a Planned Development. Also to allow structure heights over 35 feet if part of a Planned Development, or no greater than 5 over 2 if a podium building.

After the public hearings, the agenda will include the consent agenda, reports and routine matters. Also discussed will be the approval of the HOT funds in the amount of \$3,548.74 for the Chamber BBQ cook off April 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>. Also discussed will be cost share opportunities in the administrative process of the Cooper Spring Trail Grant, the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of an ordinance to consider the rezoning and SUP of 208 E. 5<sup>th</sup> St, the SUP of 1573 Barnes St., the rezoning of 707 S. Pecan, and the amendments to the city Zoning Regulations. The City Manager will request qualifications for a licensed attorney for City Prosecutor, and there will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the resolution regarding the Life Safety Grant Program. Lastly, a request to close Western St. at E. 3<sup>rd</sup> to E. 4<sup>th</sup> St. on March 19<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 12:30pm for the Boot Mural Unveiling.

After the regular session, the council will meet in executive session, then return to regular session for action on items discussed in executive session.

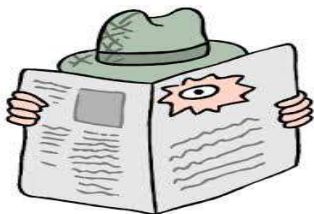
