Lampasas ISD Changes Schedule for this Friday

From Superintendent of Lampasas ISD Chane Rascoe:

Badger Nation, We will be *changing the early release day on March* 10th to a full day. Due to the inclement weather that caused the closing of school on January 31st, February 1st, and part day on February 2nd, students will need to make up some minutes to meet the minimum 75,600 instructional minutes required in Education Code 25.081. Changing the early release day will allow the district to meet the requirements without having to use the bad weather make up days that affect the Easter holiday.

City Brush Chipping Program to Begin

The City of Lampasas will begin a brush clipping program in March. There will be no charge for brush drop off at the collection station for the month of March.

The following rules apply to brush pick-up: The brush is no longer than 4 feet in length. No lumber or trash will be picked up. The bundle must be out by the curb, no alley pick up.

This week, March 6-March 10 will have pickup in the northwest section of the city, west of Key Ave. and north of 1st St. March 12-March 17 will have pickup in the southwest section of the city, west of Key Ave. and south of 1st St. March 20-March 24 will see pickup in the southeast section of the city, east of Key Ave. and south of 1st St. March 27-March 31 will see pickup in the northeast section of the city, east of Key Ave. and north of 1st St.

Note: City sponsored brush chipping will occur only during designated weeks and designated areas.

Student EKG's Offered at Lampasas Schools

Lampasas ISD is partnering with the Cody Stephens Foundation to provide EKG's and raise awareness about sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). EKG's can detect heart problems that may be missed during a standard physical.

The Cody Stephens Foundation will be on the Middle School and High School campuses March 21st to provide EKG's to students in the 6th-12th grade. The EKG's are interpreted via telemedicine by licensed cardiologists and results are returned to the school within 3 business days.

The cost of EKG's will be \$25 with \$5 of each payment going to support the HOSA program at Lampasas High School. Forms must be turned in by March 20th.

Broadband Grants

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced today his agency's intent to solicit an initial round of grant applications totaling \$120 million for broadband infrastructure projects as part of the Bringing Online Opportunities to Texas (BOOT) program. The BOOT program will support broadband infrastructure projects in eligible areas that bring reliable, affordable internet service to communities in need.

"This is an important step that my agency is taking to fulfill our legislative directive to connect every Texan to broadband service," Hegar said. "Nearly 7 million Texans don't have access to broadband services. That's 7 million Texans who can't access job postings, telemedicine appointments, work or educational opportunities from home. This grant process is a big start in bridging that digital divide."

Today the Comptroller's office posted a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and applicants have until March 17 to submit questions on the NOFA and allow this agency to make any necessary corrections to the solicitation through the addendum process. Applicants for the BOOT program can begin submitting their proposals April 3.

The NOFA was published on the TXSmartBuy website. Applicants also can visit the Comptroller's Broadband Development Office (BDO) website for more information about the application process and guidance materials and to sign up for updates about future broadband initiatives.

Eligible broadband infrastructure projects must be designed to deliver, upon completion, broadband service that reliably meets or exceeds symmetrical speeds of 100 megabits per second (Mbps). Awarded applicants must also provide a universally available low-cost option for locations being served by the project and participate in a federal broadband subsidy program.

Through the BDO, the state of Texas has been allocated \$363.8 million through the federal Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund to carry out critical infrastructure projects related to expanding access to high-speed internet. BDO will distribute funds allocated to Texas through a multi-round competitive grant process, with the first round of funds totaling \$120 million.

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Killeen Airport Receives Grant

The Killeen-Fort Hood-Regional Airport (GRK) will be awarded a \$5 million grant under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Airport Terminal Program, U.S. Secretary of Transportation Pete Buttigieg recently announced.

Killeen Executive Director of Aviation, Mike Wilson, said the grant will be used to fund a complete LED retrofit of the entire airport campus (terminal, parking lot, support buildings, etc.); installation of a solar intergraded covered parking in the car rental parking area, as well as a portion of the short-term parking lot; and a covered walkway from the terminal to the car rental lot.

"This project will not only decrease Aviation's operations budget by lowering our energy costs, but will also provide an upgrade to the customer experience by providing covered parking options at the Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport," Wilson said. "This is a competitive grant that we had to compete for against a large number of airports across the county."

Nearly \$1 billion was awarded to 99 airports in the grants, which go into effect in fiscal year 2023. The funding is from the Airport Terminal Act, one of three aviation programs created by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.
