The Weather

Today: Mostly cloudy with a high near 81°, winds from the SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy with a low near 64° and a 50% chance of thunderstorms after 9pm. Rainfall rates are forecasted to be .10-.25 inch with higher amounts in the storms. Winds will be S-SW at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Saturday: Sunshine and a high near 74°. Wind becomes N-NW early in the day and will be 10-15 mph and gusting to 25 mph. Overnight the winds die down to become light and variable, with a low near 49°.

Sunday will be mostly cloudy with a high near 66°, and E-NE wind at 5-15 mph. Rain chances at 40%. The rain chances increase Sunday night to 50%.

water to flow through the system.

If you are experiencing milky water please know that it is just air in the water and will subside”

Local Area Sales Tax Report

In Lampasas County the collections made at local businesses in January that was turned over to the state in February was higher than last year.



The City of Lampasas received a rebate check from the state for

\$146,027, which shows an increase of 7.23% over last year's check for the same period. A very nice increase.

The City of Kempner got a check for \$8,233, which shows a 2.36% increase.

The City of Lometa showed a decrease of 2.32% in their check of \$7030.

The City of San Saba, which showed a 16.04% decrease for sales in December, was down 24.72% for January as well. They received a rebate of \$39,567

Evant 's check for \$2,845 was an increase of 21.58% for January.

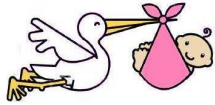
