The Weather



The high yesterday 59° This morning's low 31°.

Today: Sunny with a high near 74°. Wind will be S at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds and down to about 36°

overnight. Wind from the SE will be 5-10 mph shifting N after midnight.

Friday: Starting out cloudy with a 60% chance of rain before 9am, then sleet & rain likely between 9am & noon. The temperature should be around 31° by 9am, with the clouds clearing off and becoming mostly sunny. Wind will be N-NW increasing to 15-20 mph in the afternoon, gusting to 30 mph.

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced last week he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 913.3 million dollars in local sales tax allocations for March. These allocations are based on sales made in January by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate check increase by 10.01% over the same period last year, with a \$4633.51 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a 14.27% increase over the same period last year in their rebate check of \$58,656.34

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is up 4.57% in their rebate of \$203,308.33. Lometa shows an increase of 5.98% with a rebate check for \$7605.57. Kempner received a rebate for \$10,495.05 a 9.63% increase from last year.

Regrets. campaign to share with college students the real-life experiences of people affected by drunk driving crashes across Texas.

One person in Texas dies every eight hours and 31 minutes in a DUI-alcohol related traffic crash. Last year, 1,029 people in Texas were killed and 2,522 seriously injured because someone chose to get behind the wheel while impaired. Over last year's spring break, Texas saw 872 DUI-alcohol related traffic crashes. These crashes resulted in 30 fatalities and 107 serious injuries.

In the Brownwood District (Brown, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Lampasas, McCulloch, Mills, San Saba and Stephens counties) in 2021, there were 2,254 traffic crashes, resulting in 37 fatalities and 158 serious injuries.

In the Brownwood District in 2021, there were 139 DUI-alcohol related traffic crashes, resulting in 8 fatalities and 23 serious injuries. *(cont'd on back)*

The Blotter

The Lampasas Police blotter for Wednesday shows a reported theft in the 600 block of S. Chestnut at 3:29am. "These are disturbing numbers, especially as all of these crashes are preventable," said TxDOT Executive Director Marc Williams. "Whether it's transit, rideshare companies or a designated sober friend, there are several options for students to find a sober ride. We're hoping these real-life stories show students that deadly consequences can and do happen every year during spring break." Drinking and driving is 100% preventable and can have serious physical, emotional and financial consequences that can last for years. Not only can a DWI hurt or kill someone, devastating the lives of victims and survivors forever, it can be expensive and cause significant legal hassles. It can also make it difficult to find or keep a job and can bring a lifetime of regret.
