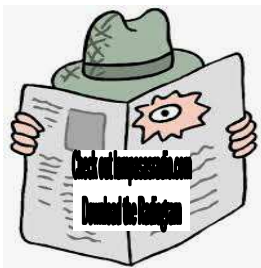

City Brush Chipping Program to Begin

The City of Lampasas will begin a brush clipping program in March. There will be no charge for brush drop off at the collection station for the month of March.

The following rules apply to brush pick-up: The brush is no longer than 4 feet in length. No lumber or trash will be picked up. The bundle must be out by the curb, no alley pick up.

March 6-March 10 had pickup in the northwest section of the city, west of Key Ave. and north of 1st St. March 12-March 17 will have pickup in the southwest section of the city, west of Key Ave. and south of 1st St. March 20-March 24 will see pickup in the southeast section of the city, east of Key Ave. and south of 1st St. March 27-March 31 will see pickup in the northeast section of the city, east of Key Ave. and north of 1st St.

Note: City sponsored brush chipping will occur only during designated weeks and designated areas.
