The Weather



The High yesterday 67° The Low this morning 52°

Today: Cloudy with a 40% chance of showers or storms with a high near 61° NE breezes around 10 mph.

Tonight: A 30% chance of showers or storms after 10pm. It will be cloudy with a low near 52° and NE wind 5-10 mph.

Tuesday Cloudy with a high of 71° with showers and thunderstorms likely in the afternoon. Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph. Rain chances are 60%.

Today

Lampasas County Commissioners met this morning at 9am for a regular session. The following was discussed:



*A motion was passed to award bid for asphalt and emulsion, with 3 bids already placed

*A motion was approved for a 4" waterline to be installed to provide water to Cottonwood Mesa Subdivision. The water line is to run under CR 3270 "by means of boring under the road 36' deep from bar ditch to bar ditch."

*All racial profiling reports were unanimously passed for Lampasas, Kempner, Lometa, and Copperas Cove police departments, along with Copperas Coves' Municipal Court.

*A Change Order Motion was passed to provide an additional 48 days to a construction contract for selection of "Brazos Blend stone in lieu of white limestone."

*A cost adjustment for the addition of variable frequency drive fans was approved.

*A discussion was held on the 2020 census information. It will now be done online instead of mailed to you. It seems scammers are trying to get personal information from people over the telephone. Bobby Carroll warns the public stating "if you receive a call from the Census Bureau of Investigations" Do not give them any of your information!

* A discussion was held about the jail project. The status of the build is going well with all the masonry work already done. Ronny Goodman who was in attendance, stated that "the metal building project will continue, with the structural steel construction to start early this week. "

Lampasas County Commissioners will have a called meeting at 1:30pm to take care of some business items. This agenda will include discussion, consideration, and possible action on Departments Heads, and an EMS/Ambulance Service presentation by LifeGuard Ambulance Service.

There will be an update on courthouse hours, as well as an update on the Jail Project.

Lampasas City Council will meet in special session at 5:30 pm to discuss litigation with the Kempner Water Supply Corp., an update on the search for a Fire Chief, the council's work plan, discussion regarding a sex offender's residency ordinance and the council's workshop format.

In regular session at 7pm, there will be the City Manager's operational report, and a resolution expressing support for the Spring Ho festival. There will also be discussion and possible action regarding the following:

*an amendment relating to the abandonment of streets, alleys, and right-of-ways

*the website photo entry contest

*funds to repair one of the city's fire engines

*The purchase of a John Deere 504E Utility tractor with Bucker Loader for the Hancock Park Golf Course in the amount of \$28,318.95

*The emergency purchase of a variable frequency drive unit for the Spring Street Pump Station in the amount of \$12,650

District Court Notes



Lampasas Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on March 8th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Judge John Gauntt. There were 38 cases presented by Lampasas County and City lawmen and the County Attorney's Office.

Altogether 38 cases were brought to the court. 29 of them involved men and 9 involved women.

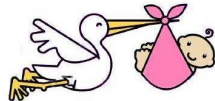

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. for Saturday shows a quiet morning, then a burglary call at 11:32 in the 1300 block of E. Ave F.

Saturday afternoon saw the arrest of a 52 year old Lometa man for driving with an invalid license and a municipal warrant for the same charge on an earlier arrest. Criminal Mischief was reported in the 500 block of S. Walnut at 7:54, then at 8:05 a 59 year old Lampasas man was taken into custody for public intoxication in the 700 block of S. Key.

A reckless driver was reported in the 400 block of S. Key at 8:33 pm. Then disturbances were reported, one in the 400 block of E. 5th at 9:10pm and one on Castleberry at 9:12pm.

Sunday morning early saw a suspicious vehicle in the 300 block of S. 281 at 12:07am. Then a minor accident in the 300 block of S. 281 at 12:35 am.

Later in the morning there was a suspicious person in the 500 block of N. Key at 6:33am. At 7:16am there was a theft reported in the 100 block of N. Walnut.

Sunday afternoon there was a reckless driver on S. 281 at 5:57pm and a suspicious person on Creek St. at 11:36pm.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter shows over the weekend, Lometa had a wreck and a report of a suspicious person. Kempner showed an alarm, civil matters and an animal complaint as well as a shots fired call.

Out in the county, deputies went out to a structure fire, civil matters, and a noise complaint. Deputies went into cove on a theft case and a trespassing call.

The Jail Log showed the County booked in a 20 year old Cedar Park man on a bond revocation

under advisement. There was one DWI case with felony repetition. Donald Wade Edmondson failed to appear on a charge of having a prohibited substance or item in a correctional facility and a warrant was issued.

Felony cases for burglary, or theft totaled two, with one involving theft of a controlled substance under \$150,000. There were two cases for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, which were reset. Nick Hernandez, in court for evading arrest/detention with a motor vehicle surrendered his bond and was taken into custody.

There were two fraud cases, and two for forgery with one dismissed. Crimes causing personal harm included 1 assault case for assault on a family member for impeding breath or circulation.

There was one sexual assault case that was reset. There were three cases for aggravated sexual assault of a child. One is set for jury trial in July and two were reset.

Of the 38 cases presented to the court five were settled. Chad Mckee of Quinlan Texas was sentenced to one day in the Lampasas County Jail with credit for time served plus costs and fees on a charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Amanda Gauna of Lampasas, on a charge of possession of a controlled substance PG 1, 1-4 grams was sentenced to 5 years of deferred adjudicated probation with a \$500 fine and costs and fees. Juliaann Maldonado of Lometa, charged with two counts of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than 1 gram was sentenced to 5 years deferred adjudicated probation with a \$1000 fine, and has to attend a SAFFP program. Justin Wayne McGehee on two charges of falsifying a statement or vehicle registration saw one dismissed and was given three years deferred adjudication probation with a \$5000 fine plus court costs on the other. Joseph Jacobs of Lampasas was

punished with 703 days in state jail with credit for time served and saw his probation revoked on a charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

The balance of the cases have been reset.
