## From TxDOT

Crews with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) have been working again this week to treat elevated structures and applying some spot treatments on state-maintained roads in the Brownwood District. All main lanes of IH 20 in Eastland County have been treated as a precaution ahead of this arctic front.

Frozen precipitation is possible early Friday morning until the early afternoon hours, according to the National Weather Service. Temperatures are anticipated to be unseasonably cold with wind chills dropping into the teens by Saturday morning.

## Texas A & M Severing Ties with Russia

(Texas Tribune) Texas A&M University Chancellor John Sharp on Wednesday moved to sever all ties with Russia, making it the first Texas university to take such action following the Russian invasion of Ukraine.



The action was disclosed in a memo Sharp sent out to school officials. He also asked agencies to review non-contractual engagements with Russian entities.

"Please note that this action is in no way an indictment of our faculty members of Russian descent nor a criticism of faculty working to improve conditions in Russia, especially for oppressed groups in that country," Sharp wrote. "I believe most, if not all, of our faculty oppose the aggression of Russian President Vladimir Putin and his cronies, and will support this action."

## The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept.** Blotter for Thursday shows a criminal trespass reported in the 200 block of S. **The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept.** Blotter for Thursday shows Lometa with a repossession. In Kempner there were reports of suspicious activity, a requested welfare check, a civil matter and a reported disturbance. Out in the county there were medical calls, a reported trespassing, an accident and a reported disturbance.

**The Jail Log** shows the arrest of 36 year old Eric Bashore II of Kempner on an out of county charge. Also arrested were 20 year old Joshua Dupree for failure to appear and 41 year old Sylvano Sanchez III for possession of marijuana 2-4 oz.

According to the memo, agreements between the school and Russia could include student and faculty exchange programs and study abroad programs. But also included are any research-related agreements that involve clinical trials, testing, data use agreements and licensing agreements.

System leaders said there are fewer than 10 research agreements across the system and they do not believe the move will have a significant impact on its 11 individual universities, eight state agencies and RELIS, A&M's research campus in Bryan. The system did not immediately respond to a request for those individual agreements. While some universities across the country have announced they are cutting financial ties, few have announced a severing of research partnerships.

Across the country, higher education has had a mixed reaction to the invasion of Ukraine. Earlier this week, the Arizona Board of Regents voted to sell off millions in Russian assets across its three university systems. The University of Colorado also announced it would liquidate its financial investments in Russia.

The University of Texas System and the Texas State University System did not immediately respond to questions as to whether they plan similar actions.
