Big Joe Lombardi; loud, jovial and blustery voiced master of the morning radio waves, decades long chief cheerleader behind a microphone for the Copperas Cove Bulldogs, and dedicated supporter of everything Fort Hood and Central Texas, has finished his tour of duty. He passed away of natural causes on Thursday evening in Killeen's Advent Hospital.

In his many years of service to area radio listeners, first at Copperas Cove's KOOV and then with Lampasas' KACQ, he was the best. In my 40-plus years of working with radio I am convinced that he was the most talented radio announcer I have ever known. Part of that was natural talent and a great voice, part was his detailed preparation, and part was his partnership with wife Sherri. She was also a lifetime member of the media business and shared his love for it. Joe worshipped her and she was his biggest fan.

Big Joe was one of the few radio DJs to have been honored in Nashville as the Country's Best of the Year, and I can attest that he deserved the honor. He was good!

Aside from work, Joe was a welcome friend to me and many others, even casual acquaintances. Whether it was a local businessman, a High School coach, a young athlete, a waitress or the postman who brought the morning mail, Joe was always quick to become a friend, and he was mine. I, like many others in the area, am glad I knew Big Joe Lombardi. **RU**

## City Council Meets

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet Monday March 13<sup>th</sup> for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion concerning the Hostess House Rehabilitation Project bid analysis, and discussion of the Comprehensive Plan implementation.

The regular session will begin immediately following the Workshop Session and may begin before 6pm. The agenda includes a public hearing on a request for a specific use permit for 101 S. Key to allow for a tire shop and discussion and possible action regarding the second reading of an ordinance to add swimming pool adult lap fees to the City of Lampasas fee schedule. Also on the agenda, Discussion and possible action on the following: the specific use permit at 101 S. Key to allow for a tire shop; the approval of a TxDOT resolution covering blanket coverage of various projects, including the installation, construction, existence, use, operation and maintenance of certain highway lighting in the City of Lampasas and an agreement for the highway lighting system between the State of Texas through TxDOT and the City of Lampasas; awarding administrative services contracts for preparation of the City's 2023-2024 Texas Community Block Grant Application, as well as administrative services for the 2023-2024 Downtown Revitalization Program Grant Application if funded to Langford Community Management Services; awarding the engineering services for the City's 2023-2024 Texas Community Block Application, as well as engineering services for the 2023-2024 Downtown Revitalization Program Grant application to Eckermann Engineering; approving an amended TxDOT resolution for the replacement or rehabilitation of the structurally deficient 3<sup>rd</sup> St. bridge as part of the Highway Bridge Replacement Programs that has been approved for 100% federal and state funding through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs ACT, whereas the local match fund participation has been waived; regarding the 2023 Consumer Price Index adjustment to Municipal Telecommunications right-of-way access line rates.

Council will then go into Executive Session to discuss the "authority of public power utility governing bodies to deliberate regarding competitive matters-utilities". Council will then return to regular session for action on items discussed in Executive Session.

## Student EKG's Offered at Lampasas Schools

**Lampasas ISD** is partnering with the Cody Stephens Foundation to provide EKG's and raise awareness about sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). EKG's can detect heart problems that may be missed during a standard physical.

The Cody Stephens Foundation will be on the Middle School and High School campuses March 21<sup>st</sup> to provide EKG's to students in the 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. The EKG's are interpreted via telemedicine by licensed cardiologists and results are returned to the school within 3 business days.

The cost of EKG's will be \$25 with \$5 of each payment going to support the HOSA program at Lampasas High School.

This year, the Lions Club and donated \$1000 to sponsor EKG's for Lampasas ISD, allowing 40 students to receive an EKG at no cost. Forms must be turned in by March 20<sup>th</sup>.
