## The Weather



The High yesterday 57° This morning's low 54°

**Today:** We are starting out the day with a dense fog advisory until noon. After noon there is a 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms. It will be cloudy with a high near 72°, and S-SE wind at 5-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Tonight:** Cloudy with a 100% chance of rain. Shower and storms are forecast mainly after 1am. Some of these storms could be severe, and new rainfall amounts between ¾ and 1 inch are expected. The low should be near 53°, with SE wind 15-20 gusting to 30 mph.

**Wednesday:** Showers and thunderstorms are likely before 10am. It should be cloudy in the morning with the skies clearing in the afternoon, and a high near 73°. W-SW wind 10-20 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Wednesday night will be mostly clear with a low around 50° and winds from the west at 10-15 mph gusting to near 20 mph.

**The rest of the week:** It looks like sunny days and with a high in the 60's on Thursday and then after a cold front and wind shift, in the 50's on Friday and Saturday.

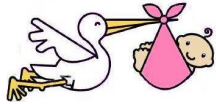

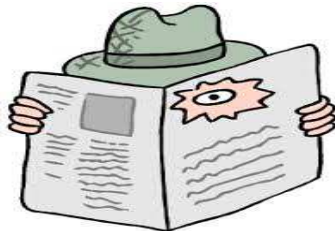
