## The Weather



The High yesterday 82° The Low this morning 64°

The frontal boundary in the region today may move farther south than thought. Where the front is located will determine where the activity will be later this afternoon. However, the S-SW winds ahead of the front will make for another very warm afternoon today. Highs will be in the 80's. .

**Today:** Mostly cloudy with a high near 84°. The wind will be S-SW at 5-15 mph. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms after 4pm.

**Tonight:** The 30% chance of storms continues this evening, then it will be cloudy with a low around 63° and S wind at 5-10 mph.

**Friday:** Cloudy with a high near 76° and a 30% chance of showers and storms in the morning. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph.

**Friday Night:** Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph, and skies will be cloudy with a low of 65°.

**Saturday:** Cloudy skies and a high temperature near 78°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-10 mph. There is a 40% chance of showers and storms.

**Saturday Night:** 62° with mostly cloudy skies, and S wind at 5-10 mph. A 30% chance of showers and storms remain.

**Sunday:** A 50% chance of showers and storms and a high temperature near 76° with cloudy skies and SE wind at 5-10 mph.

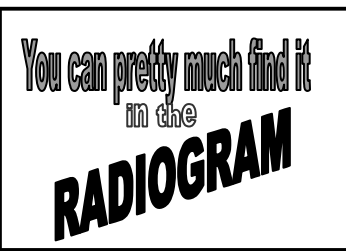

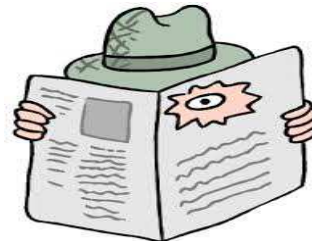
