The Forecasters say not much rain today, but the overcast skies will result in highs in the mid 70's. However, there will be several opportunities for rain over the next several days.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 75°. Wind will be S-SE at 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers and storms.

Tonight: Cloudy with a low near 64°. Winds will be SE near 10 mph. A 20% chance of showers early tomorrow morning.

Saturday: A cloudy day with a high near 77°. S-SW wind at 5-10 mph. There is a slight chance of showers increasing in the afternoon to a 30% chance.

Saturday night: Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph shifting E after midnight. There is a 30% chance of storms forecasted with a low of 60°.

Sunday: Cloudy with a high temperature near 72°. Winds will be E at 5-10 mph. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms.

Sunday night: Cloudy and a low near 61°, and a 60% chance of showers and storms. Winds will be from the E near 10 mph.

Monday: Cloudy with a high near 75° and a 60% chance of showers. Possible storms in the afternoon. Winds will be light out of the SE at 5-10 mph shifting S-SE in the afternoon.

Fort Hood Prepares Covid-19 Response



FORT HOOD, Texas -- Fort Hood and Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center leadership and staffs are in regular and close communication and coordination with federal, state, local, and private sector health partners to conduct prudent planning in regard to COVID-19. Currently, military and local area public health officials have seen no evidence of COVID-19 occurring in surrounding Central Texas communities," said Col. Jason Wesbrock, US Army Garrison Fort Hood commander. "Estimates are the current threat to public health and risk of exposure to the virus is low. Fort Hood leadership continues to prioritize the health and safety of our military, civilians and family members. We will continue to advise precautionary measures to protect the health and welfare of our community. We remind people on and off the installation to take precautions by using the following preventive measures: Avoid close contact with people who are sick. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. Wash your hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds. Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol if soap and water are unavailable," Wesbrock said. 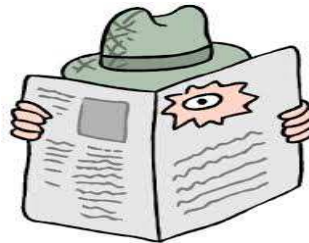

Badger Soccer is headed to Liberty Hill next Tuesday, March 17th to round out their season.

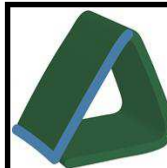
Badger Spring Tennis
