Public Hearing Scheduled

The Lampasas County Commissioners court had scheduled a public hearing for today, Monday March 14th at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse. The hearing will be on the proposed designation of a county reinvestment zone by the Commissioners Court of Lampasas. The company involved is Triple B Solar LLC and Affiliates. The public has been invited to attend.

Monday Meetings

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court has a regularly scheduled meeting today at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom at the Lampasas County Courthouse. The meeting will commence immediately after the public hearing on the Reinvestment Zone. The agenda includes the consent agenda, to include the treasurer's quarterly report and monthly reports from other county offices. Also included on the agenda is the order designating a reinvestment zone for Triple B Solar LLC and affiliates, the farmers market, the appointment of constables for Precinct 1 and Precinct 4, a racial profiling report from the Copperas Cove Police Dept., awarding a bid for asphalt and emulsion, a request bid for the depository, the contract for the annual sprinkler system inspections, the contract for the semi-annual maintenance and service agreement of the jail Kohler Generator, and the preliminary plat for the Bluffs at Yancy Creek, a subdivision.

The Lampasas City Council will meet this afternoon starting at 5:30pm for the workshop session. The agenda for the workshop session includes an update to the Covid-19 pandemic, discussion of Turner Baseball Field upgrades, discussion of the March 21st Council Work Session and discussion regarding supporting efforts by the Kiwanis Club in partnership with Landscape Structures, Inc. for a competitive grant funding for a splash pad.

The regular session will begin at 6pm. The agenda includes discussion and possible action on a request for a Specific Use Permit to allow for an open storage, display or work area for merchandise or machinery in an area zoned retail known as 102 S. Key Ave. Cont'd on back

In new business there will be discussion and possible action on approving HOT funds in the amount of \$7,287.74 for the Riata Roundup Rodeo and the LTX BBQ fest, fencing and improvement to Hanna Springs at Campbell Park and discussion regarding a letter of understanding with SCC Development regarding use of an alley located between 108 S. Key and 105 W. 1st St.
