## The Weather



**The High yesterday 67°    The Low this morning 42°**

**Today:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 57° and north wind around 15 mph with gusts to 20.

**Tonight:** Partly cloudy with a low around 36° and light north breezes.

**Saturday:** Mostly sunny with a high near 59° and NE wind at 5-10 mph. Overnight it should get down to around 39° with light to calm easterly wind.

Sunday will bring more sunshine with a high near 61° and calm wind to 5 mph later in the morning. Overnight it should get down to about 40.

**Next week:** Monday's long range forecast calls for sunshine during the day and up to around 64°. That picture will change a little overnight as a few clouds come in. The low will be about 42°. ## Train Kills Man in Cove

In a curious accident on Thursday morning a train going through Copperas Cove struck and killed a 29 yr old man walking away from it on the tracks.

Below is the complete press release:

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On March 14, 2019 at about 11:00 AM, the Copperas Cove Police Department received a report of a train pedestrian accident. The report came from the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad employees operating the train. The pedestrian was walking west on the railroad tracks adjacent to the 1200 block of FR 1113 (W Ave B). The train was traveling west approaching the location of the pedestrian. The train operator noticed the pedestrian and immediately activated the emergency stopping system for the train while signaling with the horn. The pedestrian did not take evasive action to get away from the train before being struck. The pedestrian suffered fatal injuries as a result of the collision and was pronounced deceased on scene by Justice of the Peace F.W. "Bill" Price. (He was identified as 29-year-old, Kurtis Michael Roemeling.)

The Copperas Cove Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident. The train consisted of seven cargo cars and two engines. Four of the cars were empty at the time of the collision and three were loaded with various commodities.

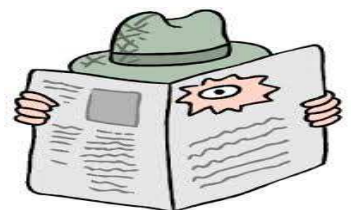
