Tax Abatement Denied

The public hearing concerning the Tax Abatement for Triple B Solar and affiliates began at 9am on Monday March 14th. The hearing was moved upstairs to the district courtroom due to the number of residents that turned out. The hearing lasted until 11:15am.

Triple B Solar and the property owner presented the project highlights, which included a 25 year lease with the owner, on less than 1500 acres and a 7% return on investment with abatements.

Approximately a dozen citizens spoke to Judge Hoyer and the commissioners. The citizens were basically against this reinvestment zone being established. The public hearing ended.

During commissioners' court, a motion was made to vote NO on the abatement and that motion was approved. The abatement was turned down. (Commissioner Rainwater stated he received 200 calls and over 100 emails on this subject).

The Commissioners stated that they were there to listen to their constituents. It was obvious how our community felt.

Ft. Hood Exercise Today

The Fort Hood scheduled power outage is happening TODAY, Tuesday, March 15.

Fort Hood will conduct an Energy Resilience Readiness Exercise (ERRE) in order to test the post's emergency systems. On this day, electrical power to nearly the entire installation will be cut. This power outage will last at least eight hours, not to exceed 12 hours.

Neither Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center nor Robert Gray Army Airfield should be affected by this exercise. (Meaning the hospital on Fort Hood will be open for Emergency care.)

Working From Home Again?

Gas prices remain high across North Texas leaving some looking for ways to lessen the financial burden of filling up their gas tanks. The pain at the pump has some people wondering if it may be time to once again return to a work from home model.

"If we look at the polling data, it's quite clear that many people still want to work from home," said University of Texas at Dallas professor emeritus Doug Kiel. "The latest data that I have, show that about 60% of people polled prefer to work from home now." One of Kiel's specialties is the nature of work and people in the workforce.

"This is a real opportunity for all of us to chip in and be good citizens. If managers will allow people to work from home, we can lower demand for gas, therefore reducing the price and help our fellow citizens who really need to use their car," Kiel said.

A recent Gallup poll found that 60% of people surveyed were in favor of a home/work hybrid while 32% were in favor of completely working from home. That study was done before gas prices skyrocketed. *(cont'd on back)*
