## The Weather

The high yesterday 81° This morning's low 49°.

Lampasas is under a wind advisory from 10am today until 7am tomorrow.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 86°. Wind will be S-SW increasing to 15-20 mph in the afternoon, with possible gusts of 30 mph.

**Tonight:** Look for mostly clear skies and down to about 45° overnight. Wind from the SW at 10-20 mph will shift to the NW late in the day and could gust to 35 mph overnight.

**Friday:** Sunny skies with a high temperature near 68°, Wind will be N-NW at 10-20 mph gusting to 40 mph.

**Friday Night:** Mostly clear and a low of 39°. Wind will be N-NW at 10-15 mph decreasing in the evening. Wind gusts of 20 mph are possible.

**Saturday:** Sunny and the high will be near 76°. Wind will become SE at 5-10 mph in the morning.

**Saturday Night:** Mostly clear and a low near 45° with a SE wind near 5-10 mph, gusting to 20 mph.

## Fire Danger Today

Significant fire activity is forecast for Thursday, March 17 due to extremely critical fire weather conditions along and west of the I-35 corridor including Gainesville, Fort Worth, Wichita Falls, Abilene, Austin, San Antonio and Del Rio regions.

High winds with low humidity moving across dry grass fuel may result in wildfires highly resistant to control. Evacuations have been common under these conditions.

This significant fire potential brings likelihood to a Southern Plains Wildfire Outbreak. This rare, high impact wildfire phenomenon is similar to Santa Ana winds and can impact parts of Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas.

"Texas A&M Forest Service has been monitoring the fire environment and increased wildfire activity this week," said Wes Moorehead, Texas A&M Forest Service Fire Chief. "The potential for significant, large wildfires has developed for tomorrow, Thursday, March 17. Wildfires that ignite under these forecast conditions are highly resistant to firefighters' suppression efforts and pose a threat to public safety. We encourage residents to be cautious tomorrow, be prepared and listen to warnings from local officials." Stay wildfire aware. If a wildfire is spotted, immediately contact local authorities. A quick response can help save lives and property.

## Lampasas Man found guilty of Manslaughter

According to a story in the Daily Trib out of Burnet; "On March 10, a Burnet County jury found Sylvano Sanchez Jr. of Lampasas guilty of manslaughter in a vehicle collision that killed Sharon Johnson and her 13-year-old son, Victor.

Sanchez was also convicted of aggravated assault of Sheldon Johnson and Sheryl Orazak, who both survived the July 2, 2018, crash on U.S. 183 south of Briggs. (Cont'd on back)

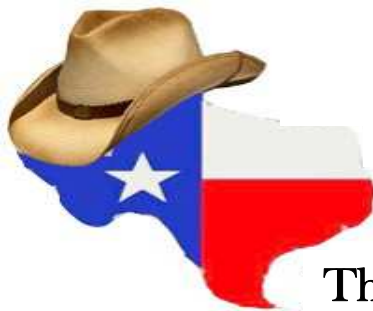

The afternoon shows the arrest of Stacey Aleman, 39, of Lampasas in the 700 block of S. Key Ave. for driving w/and invalid license and a Lampasas Municipal Warrant at 5:48pm. There was a reported harassment in the 400 block of E. 7<sup>th</sup> St. at 6:25pm, and another harassment was reported in the 700 block of W. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. at 6:40pm. There was suspicious activity reported in the 1500 block of S. Key at 9:56pm and in the 200 block of E. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. at 11:22pm. A suspicious person was reported in the 500 block of N. Race St. at 11:11pm.

**The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter** shows Lometa with a medical call, animal issues and a shots fired call. In Kempner there were medical calls, reports of suspicious activity, a grass fire, and animal issues. Out in the county there were civil matters, an accident, a reported stolen vehicle, a requested welfare check, medical calls and a reported harassment.

***The Burn Ban is in Effect!!***

The Johnson family was in the process of moving to a new home in Smithville after Sheldon Johnson's retirement as a pastor in Goldthwaite.

Sanchez was sentenced to 50 years for each conviction in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice system, according to a media release from the District Attorney's Office of the 33rd and 424th Judicial Districts, which includes Burnet County. The defendant had multiple felony convictions before the fatal crash.

Texas Department of Public Safety troopers investigating the crash determined that Sanchez was traveling at a speed of 107 mph northbound on U.S. 183 in a pickup truck when he crossed into the southbound lanes and struck the vehicle driven by Sheldon Johnson. Johnson's son, Victor, was killed instantly. Johnson suffered severe injuries.

Sanchez's truck then collided with the vehicle driven by Sharon Johnson, wife and mother of the first two victims. She was killed instantly. Her sister, Sheryl Orzak, also suffered serious injuries. Sanchez was transported to Ascension Seton Williamson, where he received treatment for a possible concussion, and was released the same day.

Assistant District Attorneys Peter Keim and Amanda Dillon prosecuted the case. Amber Vazquez and Meghan Roeper represented the defendant.
