Today: Look for partly sunny skies and a high near 56°. Wind will be N at 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.



Accident on 183/190

According to scant information from the first dispatches, one vehicle had to attempt to avoid an 18-wheeler and in doing so crashed into an oncoming car traveling on 183 about 7-8 miles out of Lampasas.

There were apparently no serious injuries but the debris field from the accident created a huge traffic backup on the highway. The traffic was literally backed up for almost 2 hours. Lometa ISD Bond Election

Lometa ISD, looking for ways to expand their vocational facilities and programs available to Lometa ISD students, is planning a new building. This will be the Advanced Technical Center, to provide more resources for career technology and vocational programs.

The Building will be 14,000 square feet, with a 5,600 square foot shop and at least 2 new classrooms, as well as an automotive bay. The new classrooms will be for health science students and a computer lab. Lometa ISD is calling a bond for 1.75 million dollars to make this happen.

Lometa ISD shares that for the past several years, the district has been lowering tax rates, and even with the passing of the bond, they estimate they will be able to lower taxes by .058, from the current \$1.06450 to \$1.0065 per \$100 of taxable value.

The election is Saturday May 6th, and the last day to register to vote is April 6th.

Lometa ISD will be having informational meetings on March 30th, April 17th and April 24th at 7pm in the Lometa school cafeteria for residents who may still have questions.
