## The Weather



**The High yesterday 64° The Low this morning 38°**

**Today:** Mostly sunny, a high near 65° and the light and variable wind will be easterly at 5-10 in the afternoon.

**Tonight:** Partly cloudy and a low around 45° with east wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the evening.

**Tuesday:** Sunny and up to 67° with SW wind 5-10 mph becoming S-SE in the morning.

Overnight it will be partly cloudy with a low around 47° and south wind 5-10 mph.

**Rest of the week:** Wednesday will bring a few clouds but still up to 66° and with calm wind becoming south.

Overnight a few clouds and down to a cool 45°.

Thursday should get up to about 69-70° in the afternoon with a cool 50° overnight.

Friday brings a 50% chance of rain and a chance for the weather to mess up Friday district baseball games around the area. The chance for spring rains goes right on through the weekend in out long range forecast, though it does decrease in likelihood through Sunday.

## District Court Notes

**Lampasas Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on March 15, 2019 Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Judge John Gauntt.



Altogether 34 cases were brought to the court. 24 of them involved men and 10 were women. Cassidy Gribble failed to appear on a charge of forgery of a financial instrument/elderly, and Camry Brown failed to appear on a charge of possession of a controlled substance, and Joseph Shanks, in court on a two charges of possession of a controlled substance left court and did not return. Warrants were issued in these cases.

There were 16 cases involving possession of a controlled substance, with 5 of them involving possession over 1 gram. There was one case for prohibited substance in a correctional facility, one case for unlawful interference or use of electronic communication, and one for unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon.

There was one case for theft, which involved a firearm, one for defrauding/misappropriation of a trust fund, and one for forgery.

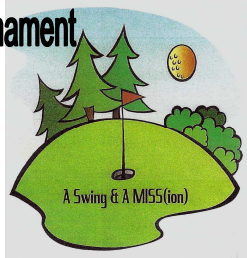

Crimes causing personal harm included 2 cases for assault on a family member and 2 cases for injury to a child w/ intent of serious bodily injury, one for indecency with a child by sexual contact, and one charge of an accident involving serious bodily injury.

Of the 34 cases presented to court, one was dismissed and 8 were settled. Rhonda Handy of Fort Worth was sentenced to 10 months state jail on a charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 under 1 gram. Israel Alvarez, for 2 charges of evading arrest with previous convictions and on for possession of a controlled substance 1-4grams, was sentenced to 7 years in TDCJ.

Jesse Garcia saw his charge of assault on a family member reduced and was punished to 157 days in the Lampasas County Jail.

Fidnecio Coronado, for failing to register as a sex offender was sentenced to 2 years in State Jail. . Regugio Gauna of Lampasas was sentenced to 6 months state jail on a charge of credit/debit card abuse, and also sentenced to 2 years TDCJ for the charge of tampering with evidence.

The balance of the cases were reset or had trials set for a future date.

**Lampasas High Steer exhibitor Koh Stapp** was also recognized Saturday morning March 16th at the Houston Livestock Show with a special cattle award and recognition. He's the son of Cassidy Mallet Stapp and a LHS FFA/4-H member.

Koh received a 2019 "Guardian Angel" award and will receive \$1000 from the Houston Steer Starlettes Steer Show support organization.

The award goes to Steer exhibitors who have overcome adversity and obstacles to participate in the annual Houston Stock Show. Koh lost his Houston Show Steer "Tank" to a sudden illness, yet showed character and determination to be a part of the 2019 Steer Show.

# The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept.** blotter for Saturday showed a noise disturbance in the 300 block of W. North Ave. at 12:48pm and otherwise a quiet morning.

The afternoon brought an unauthorized use of a motor vehicle on Landon Dr. at 12:33pm and a criminal trespass on Lively Ln. at 1:33pm. There was a burglary of a habitation in the 100 block of W. 5<sup>th</sup> at 3:18pm, a suspicious vehicle report in the 600 block of White at 3:45pm and a suspicious person in the 400 block of Naruna Rd. at 3:47pm.

Three arrests were made in the evening with the first coming on municipal court warrants for a 28 yr old man in the 100 block of W. 5<sup>th</sup>. They were all on old minor traffic warrants. The second arrest was on a 35 yr old man in the 100 block of Ohnmeiss, charged with possession of a PG1 controlled substance. Angel Marie Sandoval was charged with possession of PG1 over a gram-under 4 grams and also possession of PG3 (dangerous prescription drugs) under 28 grams and for possession of paraphernalia.

The evening brought a reckless driver on N. Key at 7pm and another minor accident in the 2000 block of Hwy 281S at 8pm. There was a disturbance reported in the 100 block of N. Key at 8:35pm
